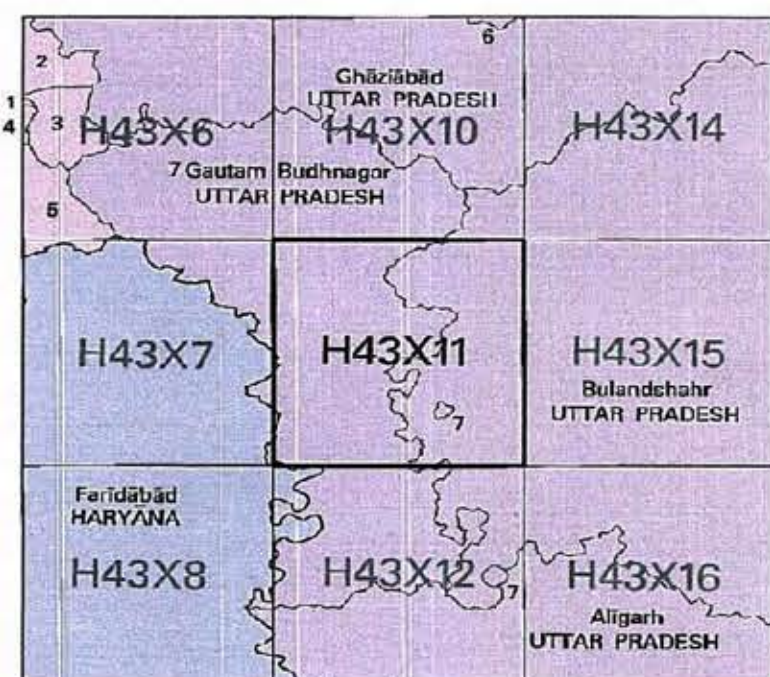

The area adjoining the Yamuna River is liable to change owing to continual fluctuation in the course of the river.
Distance shown along canals are in miles and every existing one is shown.
A relative height, e.g., 30, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
