In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC(pt) dated 3rd August 2009, wherein the MoEF Issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completion of the process of settlement of rights under the scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA' for short) on the forest land, proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes and read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013, wherein MoEF has issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 0.024 hectares of forest land, proposed to be diverted in favour of Reliance Jio Infocomm Limited for erection of Optical Fibre Cable in the existing Road passing between from Tambaram to Thiruneermalai across Pulikkuradu Reserve Forest near Tambaram in Chengalpattu District falls within jurisdiction of Tambaram Taluk, Chengalpattu District.

It is further certified that:

- (a) The proposal has been examined with a reference to ensuring compliance of Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006.
- (b) There are no scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers in Pulikkuradu Reserved forest area Tambaram Taluk, Chengalpattu District and consequently no claims have been received under Forest Right Act-2006 with respect to the area proposed for erection of OFC in the existing road section.
- (c) There are no Primitive Tribal Groups (PTG) and Pre - Agricultural Communities (PAC) in the Pulikkuradu R.F. area in Tambaram Taluk of Chengalpattu District. Hence the recognized rights of PTG and PAC are not affected.
