In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and forests ( MOEF ), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MOEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Others traditional Forest Dwellers ( Recognition of Forest Rights ) Act, 2006 ( 'FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purpose read with MOEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MOEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 9.533 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Public Works ( Roads ) Directorate, Govt of West Bengal for "Construction of Twins 2-lane ROB and its approaches in replacement of existing level crossing Gate No. KA-38(Railway Km. 165/21-165/23) between Chandrakona Road & Garbeta Stations in Kadamdiha at km 159.448 of NH-60 in the state of West Bengal" in mouzas Baradabcha (J.L.
