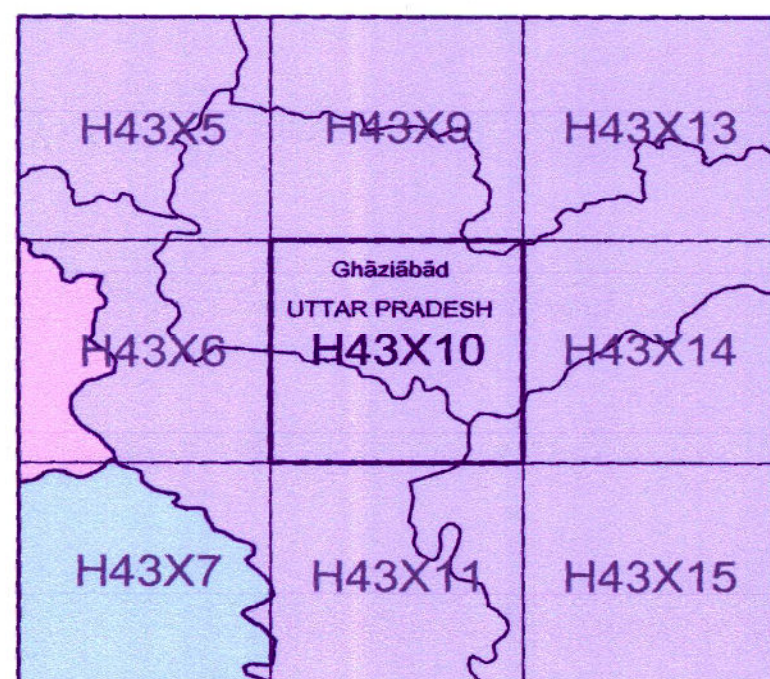

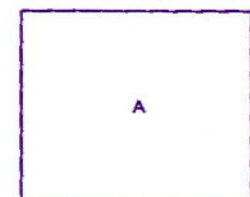

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.

Important buildings are shown in black with names.
Contour interval 10 metres.
Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to March.
Unmetalled roads and cart-tracks in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use them along canals is required from irrigation authorities.
The kilometre stone numbers along railway are shown in stent type, e.g. 5' whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g. 5'.
A relative height, e.g. 5', marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
Some of the features or symbols will appear from next edition only.
