You are requested to deposit balance amount of Rs. 8,21,00,526/- (Rupees eight crore twenty-one lakh five hundred twenty-six) only towards Net Present Value (NPV) at the rate of Rs. 9,39,000/- per ha (Eco value Class- I, Canopy Density- 0.55) as the mining lease area is coming within Naibuga & Pedipokhari RF, the density of the said RF is 40-70% of forest growth. Hence, the average density taken into consideration is 0.55 for the balance forest land over 87.434 ha in respect of Dubuna-Sakradihi Mines of M/s OMC Ltd in compliance to the condition No. A(2) of the aforementioned Stage-I approval order dated 06.05.2021 of MoEF&CC, Govt. of India.
