Sub: TSFD- FCA,1980- Diversion of 0.9723 Ha of forest land for widening and upgradation of Nakrekal – Nagarjunasagar section of NH – 565 from Km 72/460 to 73/395 (0.935 Km) in Nellikal RF, part of Amrabad Tiger Reserve of Wildlife Division, Nagarjunasagar to two lane with paved shoulder under NHDP – IV in f/o. Executive Engineer, R & B NH Division, Hyderabad – In Principle (Stage – I) approval – Accorded – **Demand notice issued** – Reg.

Adverting to the subject and reference cited, It is informed that, the Government of India, MOEF vide reference 1st cited, has accorded in-principle (Stage-I) approval for diversion of 0.9723 ha Forest Land in Nalgonda District for widening and up-gradation of Nakrekal – Nagarjunasagar section of NH – 565 from km 72/460 to 73/395 (0.935 Km) in Nellikal RF in favour of EE, R & B NH Division, Hyderabad.

In view of the above, it is requested to deposit the following payments towards NPV and other charges as shown below.

Further the User Agency shall pay an amount of **Rs.90,000/-** towards Compensatory Afforestation. The Compensatory afforestation in DFL Area shall be raised and maintained by the State Forest Department over 1 Ha of forest land identified in Compt.No.72, Nellikal RF of Nagarjunasagar Range.

As per the Government of India condition No. (vii), the User Agency should compulsorily deposit the NPV & CA amount to CAMPA only through e-portal (<http://parivesh.nic.in/>);

Further, the User Agency has to deposit the following amount in the account of Forest Divisional Officer, Wildlife Management, Nagarjunasagar **Andhra Bank, Hill colony, Nagarjunasagar** (A/c No **039910100068588**, IFSC Code : **ANDB0000399**).

Further the User Agency shall pay an amount of **Rs. 28,00,000/-** (Rupees Twenty eight Lakhs only) towards Mitigation Measures and Water Conservation Measures. The above amount is to be deposit with the **Chief Wildlife Warden, Name of the Account: Biodiversity Conservation Society of Telangana, A/c.No.110310100030284, Andhra Bank, Secretariat Branch, Hyderabad, IFSC Code: ANDB0001103.**


Other Conditions to be complied with by the User Agency:

1. Condition No. (ii) - The demarcation of the proposed forest area shall be carried out by erecting 4 feet high cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters at the cost of User Agency.
2. Condition No.(iii) – No tree to be felled in the diverted forest area.
3. Condition No. (iv) - The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value of the diverted forest land measuring 0.9723 Ha from User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated.28.03.2008 and 09.05.2008 in I.A Nos.826 in 566 with related IA's in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995.
4. Condition No.(v) – Additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be charged by the State Government from User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
5. Condition No.(vii) – The funds received from the User Agency under the project shall be transferred / deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (<http://parivesh.nic.in/>).
6. Condition No. (x) –Roadside cuttings and fillings which require engineering support shall be provided as per the instructions of the DFO concerned so as to stabilize the soil.
7. Condition No.(xi) - The dug out material / overburden shall be dumped outside the forest area. Storage of any material shall not be done in the forest area.
8. Condition No. (xii) – The layout plan of the shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.
9. Condition No. (xiv) - The User Agency shall provide firewood preferebaly alternate fuel to labourers working at the site to avoid damage / tree felling and no labour camp shall be established inside the forest area.
10. Condition No.(xv) – Disturbance shall be kept minimum by creating labour camps outside the forest area as far as possible and it shall be responsibility of the User Agency to ensure that the labourers& staff engaged in execution of work do not destruct nearby forest flora & fauna.
11. Condition No.(xvi) – The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 0.9723 ha and the forest area diverted shall not be used for any purpose other than those shown in the diversion proposal. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
12. Condition No.(xvii) – The forest land proposed for diversion shall under no circumstances be transferred or sublet to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Central Government.
13. Condition No. (xviii) – The User Agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.
14. Condition No.(xix) – Any other conditions that the Central Government or Regional Officer (Central) of Integrated Regional Office, Hyderabad may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the User Agency.
15. Condition No.(xx) - In the event of failure to comply with any of the above conditions the user agency is liable for penal action as per the Rules/Guidelines issued under FCA,1980.

The chain link fencing is not required since the NBWL has prescribed the Fly over covering the entire stretch of proposed forest area and vents are also provided, hence chain link fencing is not required.

After receipt of the compliance report on the above mentioned conditions, the proposal will be considered for final approval. Transfer of forest land to the user agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final approval. This in-principal approval is valid for the period of (5) years. In the event of non compliance of the above conditions, this in-principal approval shall automatically stand revoked after (5) years.


