Besides the above, the user agency to comply with the following instructions issued by the G.O.I issued vide F.No.7-23-2012-Fc; Dt: 24.07.2013.

- 1. Publish entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the condition and safe guards imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspapers one is vernacular language and the other in English granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for non-Forestry purposes.
- 2. The copies of the Forest clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

In view of the above, the user agency is requested to deposit the above amounts, comply with all the instructions issued in the reference 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> cited, furnish copies of newspaper clippings published on forest clearance and compliance report on the conditions stipulated in stage-I approval along with necessary enclosures as evidence in five sets for onward submission to the nodal officer.

It is further clarified that the transfer of forest land shall not be affected prior to the issue of final approval (or working permission whichever is earlier).
