Proposal for diversion of 8.22 ha. of Forest Land for widening of Ambadi-Jawarla Road in Nanded district of Maharashtra.

Sir,

The Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Nodal Officer, M.S., Nagpur has submitted proposal is for diversion of 8.22 ha. of forest land under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for widening of Ambadi-Jawarla Road, MDR-94, chainage 00.00 km to chainage 6.850 km in Tal. Kinwat, District. Nanded. The details of forest land proposed for diversion is as given below: -

The Project has been initiated by Executive Engineer, Forest Department, Nanded District.

2. The Project has been initiated by Executive Engineer, Public Works Division, Bhokar for approval under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. The widening of Ambadi-Jawarla Road, MDR-94, chainage 00.00 km to chainage 6.850 km is passing through Nanded Forest Division, Nanded. The village of Jawarla Tal. Kinwat Dist. Nanded in the State of Maharashtra is adopted by Hon'ble Governor of Maharashtra Shri. C. Vidyasagar Rao vide letter No. RB/DB/E-13016(6)2015/Adoption of village/356 dated. 19/05/2015. The stretch between Jawarla and kinwat is 38.00 Km and the existing width is 3.65 mt. If this road is revived and asphalted the distance between Jawarla & Taluka headquarter of kinwat will reduce and shall be convenient access to tribal people to kinwat will be done. The Implementation of entire project will ensure

fast and safe road traffic movement, reducing travel time. The proposed project also aims at creation of commercial nodes for multiple development mainly in industrial, commercial, agricultural, tourism sector resulting in to employment generation, capacity building as well as connectivity between industrial place. Due to the proposed project travel time will be saved. Fuel and maintenance of vehicles will be reduced. It will provide safe and faster transport and serve better connectivity in the region.

3. The proposed project area belongs to Eco value class-III and having density of forest below 0.4.
4. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Nanded has certified that the no alternate alignment is possible and the forest land required is the barest minimum.
5. There are 1283 trees of various species and trees is involved in implementation of the Project.
6. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Nanded has certified that the area involved does not form part of any existing National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Nature Reserve etc. as certified by the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Nanded.
7. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Nanded has certified that the proposed project is beyond 10 km of the boundaries of the (National Park & Wildlife Sanctuary).
8. The Project Authority has submitted an undertaking to defray the cost of Net Present Value of the forest land proposed for diversion.
9. The User Agency has agreed to defray the cost of Compensatory Afforestation.
10. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Nanded has certified that the proposed site is not likely to affect any monuments site of cultural, historical, religious archaeological or recreational importance.
11. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Nanded has given suitability certificate for 8.22 ha non-forest land in Survey no. 85 in village Bhilgaon, Tal.Kinwat, District Nanded is handed over to the Forest Department in lieu of the aforesaid project is contiguous to forest area, suitable for afforestation and free from encroachment and encumbrances.
12. The user agency has submitted the certificate of Collector, Nanded under Schedule Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dweller's (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006.
13. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Nanded has certified that there is no violation of Forest (Conservation) Act 1980.
14. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Maharashtra State, Nagpur has recommended the proposal subject to the conditions, given in his specific recommendations, under Section-2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. His specific recommendations are enclosed in the proposal.
15. In the circumstances explained in the aforesaid paragraphs and enclosures, the State Government recommends that the said forest land may be allowed to be diverted on the conditions proposed by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Maharashtra State, Nagpur. The matter may kindly be placed before the Government of India for its approval under Section-2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, be obtained and communicated to this Government at earlier.
