With reference to the subject and reference cited, It is submitted that the Stage- I (in-principle) approval has been accorded by the State Government for diversion of forest land 0.80 Ha of forest land in for Widening and Strengthening of road from Nizamabad to Varni in Km 17/730 to 19/100 & 24/0 to 24/816.7 in Mosra RF and Ghanpur RF of Nizamabad Division and District in favour of R & B Department and communicated in reference 2nd cited for raising of demands in consultation with Nodal Officer (FCA) and to obtain the compliance report on the conditions stipulated by the Government from the user Agency and furnish same for obtaining State -II (Final) approval.

The Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, TS, Hyderabad has further requested the DFOs/FDOs to issue the demand notice to the User Agency in consultation with Nodal Officer for Forests (Conservation) Act, 1980 for payment of Net Present Value (NPV), Cost of CA, Cost of Construction of Boundary Pillars and Extraction of the Tree Growth etc., and issue the demand to the User Agency only after vetting by the Nodal Officer.

Further, the user agency is requested to comply with the following in accordance with the guidelines issued vide F. No. 7-23/2012-FC, dt 24.07.2013 communicated vide P.C.C.F, Nizamabad dt. 23.08.2013, at the cost of the Project proponent:

1. Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the conditions and safeguards imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspapers one in Telugu language and the other in English language so as to make people aware of the forest clearance granted to the project proponent for use of forest land for non-forest purposes.

2. Copies of the Forest Clearance should also be submitted to the Heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal Bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

Further, the user agency will be requested to furnish compliance report along with all required relevant information/documents etc., as stipulated in reference 1st cited above for Stage-I approval at the earliest, so as to submit the condition wise compliance report to higher authorities for obtaining Stage-II approval.
