Diversion of 5.915 ha of forest land for access road for laying OFC under NOFN Project of M/s BSNL in Chogawan and Rayya Block under Forest Division and Distt. Amritsar.

Your letter No. 1962 dated 04.06.2015.

Government of India has accorded general approval under the Forest Conservation Act, 1980 vide letter No. 11-9/98-FC dated 8-04-09 in the cases of laying of Underground Telephone Lines, Optical Fiber Cable and Underground Laying of Drinking Water Supply Pipeline.

After careful consideration of the proposal submitted vide your letter under reference general approval of Govt. of India under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1930 for temporary diversion of **5.915 ha** of forest land for digging of trenches measuring 130000 mtrs. long and 0.45 mtrs wide along the road for laying of Optical Fiber Cable is hereby conveyed subject to the following conditions: -

1. Legal status of the forest land will remain unchanged.
2. The forest land will not be used for any other purpose.
3. No tree will be felled.
4. Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide order dated 28-3-08 in I.A No. 826 in 566..... in W.P.(C) 202 of 1995 has fully exempted NPV provided: (a) no felling of trees is involved; and (b) the areas fall outside National Park/Wildlife Sanctuary.
5. The Optical Fiber Cable will be laid along the road within the existing right of way and close to the outermost edge of the forest land. The dug out land shall be restored by the User Agency and the same shall be made good immediately after the approved operation.
6. This approval is subject to the clearance of the proposal under relevant local Acts/Rules/Court's Rulings/instructions etc. as applicable.
7. The User Agency shall seek prior permission from the DFO, Amritsar for carrying out any maintenance operation.
8. The User Agency shall abide by any other condition (s) that may be imposed by this Department in the interest of afforestation and protection of environment.
9. The State Forest Department may revoke/suspend this approval, if any of the above conditions is not satisfactorily fulfilled by the User Agency.
10. An undertaking be signed by the User Agency for abiding by all the aforesaid conditions.
11. If any other NOC is necessary under any Act/Rules/Guidelines etc. from other Departments, the user agency should obtain the same before the commencement of laying of Cable.
12. DFO, Amritsar has directed to the User Agency for deposit the Bank Guarantee in this case.
13. DFO, Amritsar will allow the work to be started only after receipt of the final NOC from the PWD/NHAI.
14. The user agency shall provide certificate regarding Scheduled Tribes and Traditional Forest Dwellers Recognition of Forest Rights Act, 2006 from the concerned Deputy Commissioner to Divisional Forest Officer.
15. CF, Bist/DFO, Amritsar shall ensure fulfillment of the above conditions.
