With reference to the memo cited above on the captioned subject, the site specific interventions pertaining to the project i.e. proposal for seeking prior approval under section 2(ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 in favour of M/s. Mahanadi Coalfield Limited for non-forestry use of 417.037 Ha. & Re-diversion (Change of land use) of 171.774 Ha. forest land in respect of Integrated Lakhanpur-Belpahar-Lilari Opencast Project of Lakhanpur Area in district Jharsuguda in Odisha is approved as part of the Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan based on Landscape Approach approved by the PCCF(WL) vide Memo No.8369/2024, dt.22.07.2024.
