- Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land being diverted for non-forestry purpose may be realized from the user agency, as per MoEF&CC directions issued vide letters No. 5-3/2007-FC dated 5th February 2009 and Hon'ble Supreme Court of India's Order dated 30th October 2002, 28th March, 2008, 24th April, 2008 and 9th May 2008;
- The Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land and all other CA levies shall be iii) deposited through web portal of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change www.parivesh.nic.in;
