The Government of India Ministry of Environment and Forest Climate Change Regional Office, Bangalore has accorded Stage-I approval for diversion of 34.98 ha. of forest land subject to fulfillment of certain conditions in vide letter cited at reference (1). Accordingly the compliance report submitted to the Government through proper channel vide this office letter dated: 12-02-2021 cited at reference (6). In the meantime the Government of India Ministry of Environment and Forest Climate Change Regional Office, Bangalore has revised the rate of Net Present Value vide their letter dated: 06-01-2022 cited at reference (5). Accordingly you have been requested to pay the differential amount of Net Present Value vide this office letter dated: 12-02-2021 cited at reference (6).

But, as per your letter dated: 05-08-2022 cited at reference (4) stated that, you have uploaded demand notice in parivesh portal and further it is rejected and stated that, revised

NPV charges does not applicable to this project. This has been also accepted by this office as per Nodal Officer, Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Forest Conservation), Bangalore direction that in similar case. Further it is informed that the Government of India Ministry of Environment and Forest Climate Change Regional Office, Bangalore has accorded in principal approval subject to certain conditions out of which condition No. A(2) is that,

The User Agency shall transfer the cost of raising and maintaining the compensatory afforestation at the current wage rate in consultation with Sate Forest Department in the account CAMPA of the concerned State through online portal. The scheme may include demarcation of non forest land using chain link fencing with provision of **watering** and SMC works and appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years."

As per this condition you have paid the compensatory afforestation charges which is excluding watering charges of seedlings. Hence it is requested to pay the watering charges as under.
