Compensatory Afforestation (Condition No.5): (a) Compensatory Afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over an identified 8.00 Ha of degraded forest land (Compartment No.225, Chichupally Beat & Section of Manikgarh RF, Asifabad Range, Kumurambheem Asifabad District) at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided. (b) The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years. Publish the entire forest clearances granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purpose in verbatim along with the conditions and safe-guards imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspaper i.e., one is vernacular language and the other in English.
 - 2. The copies of the clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days from the date of receipt of this reference.
- 2. Further the User Agency is requested to submit separate undertakings for each of the condition Nos. 1 to 21 as in the approval letter by IRO and also communicated by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, (HoFF), Telangana, Hyderabad. Further the UA shall comply to the instructions of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, (HoFF), Telangana, Hyderabad communicated vide ref, 3rd and 4th cited above.
- 3. Further the User Agency is requested to submit separate undertakings for each of the condition Nos. (I) to (XIII) as per the. MoM of 72nd (Part) SC-NBWL meeting held on 12.06.2023 and communicated by the Prl. C.C.F., CWW, TS, Hyderabad Rc. No. 8776/2021/WL-1, Dt.01.08.2023.
- 4. Further, the User Agency is requested to submit the details of payments made and submit seven sets of compliance report on all the conditions stipulated in Stage-I approval and in NBWL approval along with all the necessary documents, certificates, undertaking and also paper clippings etc.,
