Sub: Forest (Conservation) Act- Diversion of forest land to an extent of 2.6209 Ha (proposed 2.3874 ha) in WLM Eturnagaram forest division under Mulugu District for laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road and within the existing Right of Way in favour of M/S Jio Digital Fibre Limited – In-Principle (Stage-1) approval accorded – **Demand notice issued – Regarding**

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With reference to the subject cited above, it is informed that the Forest Divisional Officer, WLM Eturnagaram vide reference 10<sup>th</sup> cited has requested to raise demand notice towards diversion of 2.6209 Ha (proposed 2.3874 ha.) of forest land in WLM Eturnagaram Forest Divisions in Mulugu District for laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road and within existing Right of Way in favour of M/s Reliance Jio Infocomm, Hyderabad for which In-principle (Stage– I) approval was accorded vide reference 9<sup>th</sup> cited above with a request to raise the demand notice over M/s Reliance Jio Infocomm, Hyderabad for making payment of compensatory levies and to obtain the compliance report on Stage – I approval & furnish through the Chief Conservator of Forests, Warangal for obtaining Stage – II (Final) approval..

In this regard, it is submitted that for diversion of above said forest land, the said area falls under the jurisdiction of WLM Eturnagaram Division to an extent of 2.6209 Ha in Mulugu District and the area details are as follows.

The User Agency will be directed to deposit the compensatory levies towards CA, NPV etc., into the Telangana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) saving bank Account through online mode only, through e-portal method at MoEF&CC, GOI, New Delhi portal i.e., <http://parivesh.nic.in> by generating the challan in consultation with Nodal Officer, Telangana State Forest Department. The user agency needs to upload the demand notice against the project for approval by Nodal Officer (FCA), Telangana and generate challan after approval. The payment to be made against the Challan number and the Challan is valid for one week. A step-by-step process is available at <http://parivesh.nic.in>.

Further it is submitted that, as per the Circular instructions vide PCCF, TS HYD, Rc. No. 03/2015/FCA-1, 13.09.2017 erecting of Reinforced cement concrete pillars have been calculated and the charges has to be paid by the user agency in WLM Eturnagaram, Union bank of India, Mangapet Ac. No. 086610100143719 IFSC Code. UBIN0808661. The details of demand notice is as shown below.

Further, the User Agency has to comply with following in accordance with the MoEF&CC, GoI instructions issued vide F.no.7-23-2012-FC, Dt.24.07.2013 communicated vide Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, A.P. Hyderabad Rc.No.45921/2001/F4, Dt.23.08.2013:

- a) Publish the entire forest clearances granted in verbatim along with the condition and safe-guards imposed by the Central government in two widely circulated daily newspaper one in vernacular language and the other in English granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purposes.
- b) The copies of the forest clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days.

Further, the User Agency has to furnish the compliance on the conditions stipulated in the Stage I approval for onward submission to Government for obtaining Stage-II approval.

The transfer of forest land to User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final (Stage II) approval or working permission.
