Sub:- TSFD - F(C) Act, 1980 – PR Division Mancherial – PMGSY XI - Proposals seeking diversion of 4.8409 Ha (4.0977 Ha in Chennur Division and 0.7432 Ha in Bellampally Division) of forest land for improvement of existing road to BT Standard from 6/600 to 8/800 Km on RF Laxmipur to Baddampally in Vemanapally Mandal (including construction of two bridges) in Chennur RF of Chennur and Bellampally forest Divisions of Mancherial District in favour of District Panchayat Raj Engineer (PIU), Mancherial - In-Principle (Stage-I) approval accorded – Demand notice issued- Regarding.

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1. With reference to the subject and references cited above, it is submitted that, the Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate change, Integrated Regional Office, Hyderabad vide reference IRO MoEF & CC, GoI, Hyderabad vide reference 3rd cited above, has accorded in principle (Stage-I) approval for diversion of 4.8409 Ha (4.0977 Ha in Chennur Division and 0.7432 Ha in Bellampally Division) of forest land for improvement of existing road to BT Standard from 6/600 to 8/800 Km on RF Laxmipur to Baddampally in Vemanapally Mandal (including construction of two bridges) in Chennur RF of Chennur and Bellampally forest Divisions of Mancherial District in favour of District Panchayat Raj Engineer (PIU), Mancherial subject to compliance of conditions stipulated therein which has been communicated by the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests TS Hyderabad vide reference 4th cited and requested the Forest Divisional Officers Chennur and Bellampally to raise the demand notice as per the actual rates and submit the demand notice to the nodal Officer for vetting. Further Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, TS Hyderabad has informed that, only after vetting of the demand note by the Nodal officer, the District Forest Officer/Forest Divisional Officers should raise demand with the User Agency, for deposition of funds into respective accounts indicated in the demand notice by the User Agency.
2. Accordingly, the demand as approved by the Nodal Officer (FCA) O/o Prl.CCF, TS, Hyd vide reference 6th cited above is raised as follows to make payment of various compensatory levies.
 - a. The User Agency shall deposit an amount of (i) **Rs. 786000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs Eighty Six thousand only)** in favour of Forest Divisional Officer, Bellampally PD A/c No. 37110004892, State Bank of India, Branch: Bellampally IFSC: SBIN0020120 and (ii) **Rs. 2425300/- (Rupees Twenty Four Lakhs Twenty Five thousand Three Hundred only)** in favour of Forest Divisional Officer, Chennur PD A/c No. 62490360405 State Bank of India, Branch: Chennur, IFSC: SBIN0020128.

Further, the User Agency shall compulsorily deposit an amount of **Rs. 3030403/- (Rupees Thirty Lakhs Thirty thousand Four Hundred and Three only)** towards cost of NPV & CA, into Telangana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) saving bank Account through the Ministry's Website i.e., <http://parivesh.nic.in> by generating the challan in consultation with the Nodal Officer (FCA) O/o Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, TS, Hyderabad. The user agency needs to upload the demand notice against the project for approval by Nodal Officer (FCA), Telangana and generate challan after approval. The payment to be made against the Challan number and the Challan is valid for one week. A step-by-step process is available at <http://parivesh.nic.in>. Further, the User Agency shall deposit the above amount **Rs. 150,08,000/- (Rupees One Crore Fifty lakhs Eight thousand only) in favour of Forest Bio-Diversity Conservation Society of Telangana A/c No.110310100030284, IFSC Code UBIN0811793, Union Bank of India, Secretariat Branch, Hyderabad.**

3. Further, the User Agency is requested to intimate the details of payments made and submit seven sets of compliance report on all the conditions stipulated in Stage-I approval along with all the necessary documents, certificates, undertaking etc., to the Forest Divisional Officers, Bellampally & Chennur for submitting their remarks on condition wise compliance report to this office for onwards submission to the competent authority for issue Stage-II approval.
4. The User Agency is requested to comply with the following accordance with the Government of India instructions issued vide F.No.7-23/2012-FC, Dt.24.07.2013 communicated vide PCCF's Rc.No.45921/2001-F4, Dt.23.08.2013 and publish the orders at the cost of the project proponent.
 - a) Publish the entire forest clearance granted in verbatim along with the conditions and safeguards imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspapers, one in vernacular language and the other in English language, so as to make people aware of the permission granted to the project proponent for use of forest land for non-forest purpose.
 - b) The copies of the Forest Clearance should also be submitted to the Head of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal Bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same in 30 days from the date of receipt of this reference.
5. Further, the User Agency is requested to furnish undertakings on C. No. i, viii, x, xi, xii, xiii, xiv, xv, xvii, xviii, xix, xx, xxi, xxii, xxiii, xxiv & xxv
6. The transfer of forest land to User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final (Stage II) approval or working permission.

In view of the above, the District Panchayath Raj Engineer (PIU) Mancherial is requested to submit the compliance report as per the above for taking further course of action in the matter.
