
Sub:- APFD — Forest (C) Act, 1980 — Diversion of 3.63 ha of forest land in Compartment no 347 and 348 of Chippapalli RF, Vizianagaram Division for formation of BT to the road from Gummakota to Galipadu in favour of EE, PR(PIU), Division, Paderu — In-principle (Stage-I) approval accorded — Orders communicated — **Revised** Demand notice issued - Reg.

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In continuation of this office reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited, It is informed that, in the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited, the Government of Andhra Pradesh have issued a memo where in the Government of India, MoEF & CC, IRO, Vijayawada have accorded in principal (Stage-I) approval for diversion of 3.63 ha of forest land for formation of BT to the road from Gummakota to Galipadu in Compt. No. 347 and 348 of Chippapalli RF of Rompilli beat, Bhimpolu Section of Paderu division (erstwhile Andra section of Vizianagaram division) in favour of EE, PR(PIU) Division, Paderu subject to fulfillment of approval under section certain conditions as stipulated therein.

Hence, the Executive Engineer, Panchayat Raj, PIU Division, Paderu is requested to go through the conditions stipulated from i to xxv in the GOI, MoEF&CC, IRO, Vijayawada Ir.F.no.4-APB205/2023-VIJ/996, dt.16.06.2023 as per reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited and also follow the instructions issued by the Prl.Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF) A.P. Mangalagiri in the reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited without any deviation as given below. A copy of the above references are enclosed herewith.



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- 1) Publish the entire forest clearance granted in verbatim along with the conditions and safe guards imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspapers, one in vernacular language and another in English language so as to make people aware of the permission granted to the project proponent for use of forest land for non-forestry purposes.
- 2) The copies of the Forest Clearance should also be submitted to the Heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal Bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn have to display the same for 30 days.

As per the condition no (vii) the user agency shall pay the Net Present Value of the diverted forest land measuring 3.63 ha from the User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 28.03.2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA Nos. 826 in 566 with related IA's in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 202/1995 and Ministry's guideline No. 5-3/2011-FC (Vol-I) dated 06.01.2022 and clarification issued vide letter dated 19.0.2022 and 22.03.2022.

As per the condition no viii) additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.

The above NPV rate is computed based on the information about forest type and density given in the Compartment history of approved working plan of Vizianagaram division and also duly taking the information furnished in the Divisional Forest Officer's field inspection note into consideration and NPV rates of Eco-class communicated by Govt. of India, MoEF&CC, dated.06.01.2022.

Although the forest density is shown as 0.1-0.4 in the compartment history, the Divisional Forest Officer had mentioned in his field inspection that the canopy density as **about 0.4**. Hence the higher side of the value (density > 0.4) is taken here for computation of NPV.

#### I. (a) Procedure for e- challan generation:

- i) On issue of this demand notice, the user agency shall log in to generate e-challan and make payment against the demand.
- ii) Agency shall fill all the details as per the format provided in the portal and submit to Nodal Officer for verification.
- iii) Once it is verified by Nodal Officer, Agency can generate e-challan from the portal.

#### I. (b) Procedure for Payment through RTGS:

- iv) For payment through RTGS, the representative of the agency should visit his bank branch (RTGS enabled) of a Bank of his choice along with printed echallan with an Account Number printed on it.
- v) While tendering the e-challan at the bank, the agency must ensure that the unique account number mentioned in the challan should be correctly mentioned as the account number in which funds to be remitted.
- vi) Upon executing the RTGS by the sender/ remitter bank, the amount collected will be credited to relevant CAMPA state account with the Bank on real time basis.
