M/s. JSW Steel Ltd., Geetapuram, Dolvi, Tal. Pen, Dist Raigad has submitted a proposal for diversion of 0.1186 ha of Reserved Forest (MPFA, 1975 & U/s 4 IFA, 1927), Reserved Forest and Unclassed Forest land for laying of under ground 1100 mm water pipeline for industries use & 400 mm dia water pipeline for drinking purpose nearby villages from Patansai (Tal. Roha) to Karav (Tal. Pen) in Raigad district. The details of land proposed for diversion is as under-

2. Total non-forest area involved in this project is 6.2980 ha. The total water requirement for the proposed expansion project and township will be around 112.16 MLD (4673 cum/hrs). To cater this additional water requirement, new water pipeline of 1100 mm dia is being laid from Chikni (Nagothane) to Dolvi Complex. The line is route along NH-17 within utility corridor approved by NHAI. The pipeline is going to be utilized to cater the increased water requirement of the expanded Dolvi Steel Complex of JSW Steel Ltd. And laying of 400 mm dia pipeline in utility corridor of NH-17 to meet the drinking water requirement of enroute villages at User Agency cost. Both the pipeline are routed along NH-17 within utility corridor approved by NHAI.
3. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Alibag has certified that no alternate alignment is possible and the forest land required is the barest minimum.
4. No cutting and felling of trees is involved in implementation of the project.
5. There is a violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 as certified by the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Alibag. However, it is not violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 but violation of Indian Forest Act, 1927 as the agency is a private entity. User Agency has constructed the bridge & laid pipeline over an area of 0.1136 ha forest land in the year 2013 to 2015. As per report of violation, this is case of mistake of fact the utility corridor provided by National Highway 17 and in the agreement with JSW Steel Ltd (User Agency) regarding uses of utility corridor it was presumed that all land related permission were granted by the various Government agencies hence the work was undertaken. Violation report is enclosed in the proposal.
6. The project area belongs to Eco-Value class I Category open.
7. The User Agency has submitted an undertaking to defray the cost of Net Present Value of the forest land proposed for diversion.
8. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Alibag has certified that the proposed project is beyond 10 km of the boundaries of the Protected Area (Sachin Wildlife Sanctuary).
9. The area involved does not form part of any existing National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary or Nature Reserve etc.

10. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Alibag has certified that proposed project is not likely to affect any monuments site of cultural, historical, religious archeological or recreational importance.

11. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Alibag has certified that the private area / non forest area which is to be acquired for the project is neither deemed Reserve Forest under the Maharashtra Private Forests (Acquisition) Act, 1975 nor it has been identified as "Forests" as envisaged in the interim order given by the Honorable Supreme Court dated 12/12/1996.

12. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Alibag has certified that 1.00 ha. degraded forest land in Comptt. No. 384/A at village Sukeli, Ta. Roha, Dist. Raigad proposed for Compensatory Afforestation is suitable for afforestation & management purpose and also free from encroachment and encumbrances.

13. The User Agency has fulfilled the compliance under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Rights) Act, 2006.

14. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Maharashtra State, Nagpur has recommended the proposal subject to the conditions, given in his specific recommendations, under Section-2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. His specific recommendations are enclosed in the proposal.



In the circumstances explained in above paragraphs and enclosures, the State Government recommends that the said forest land may be allowed to be diverted for the non-forestry use on the conditions proposed by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Maharashtra State, Nagpur. The matter may kindly be placed before Government of India for its approval under Section-2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and the same may please be obtained and communicated to this Government at earliest.
