The Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Maharashtra State, Nagpur has submitted proposal for diversion of 18.18 ha. forest land AU-108-Two lanning of District Boundary to Chuncha-Manatha-Barad-Mudkhed Road with paved shoulder in Nanded District under HAM SH-261 of Km 000/000 to Km.48/700 and AU-109 Two Lanning of Mudkhed-Gadga-Khandgaon-Mukhed-Savargaon (BK)-Jamb to district Border Road with paved shoulder in Nanded-District SH-261 Km-48/700 to 97/951 in the State of Maharashtra.

The User Agency has given justification for locating the project in forest land that 2. AU-108-Two lanning of District Boundary to Chuncha-Manatha-Barad-Mudkhed Road with paved shoulder in Nanded District under HAM SH-261 of Km 000/000 to Km.48/700 and AU-109 Two Lanning of Mudkhed-Gadga-Khandgaon-Mukhed-Savargaon (BK)-Jamb to district Border Road with paved shoulder in Nanded-District SH-261 Km-48/700 to 97/951. The Government of Maharashtra has taken up a massive programme of up-gradation and development of existing two-lane State Highways. This stretch passes through Nanded district. The Nanded district is foremost players in tourism and aided industry along with agricultural. It is a need of an hour for better transportation facilities to cope up with future demands. This state highway connects to other State highways. Considering all the major factors, the Government has taken a policy decision of developing this state highway for better and safe transportation. This entire stretch starting form District Boundary to Chuncha CH-0/00 and ends of Jamb to District Border CH-97/Provides connectivity to various important religious place, important places of trades, other national and state highways. This project shall help in achieving the following objectives amongst others. 1) Easy and fast transfer between modes. 2) Cost saving over development of separate corridors for each transportation & utility supply modes. 3) Reduction of Pollution. 4) High speed of movement, faster connectivity and subsequent speedy disposal of vehicle. No alternatives non forest is required to be studied as the proposal is for up-gradation and development of existing tow lane State Highways except with small curve improvement which are unavoidable.

# 3. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Nanded has certified that:-

- 3.1 No suitable alternate non-forest land is available and demand for the forest land is minimum.
- 3.2 Provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and guidelines under its have been violated in the proposed project. The detailed Violation report is enclosed in the proposal.
- 3.3 The proposed area belongs to Eco value class-III, Dense Forest having density below 0.04.
- 3.4 There are 4688 trees cutting and felling involved in the project.

- 3.5 The Painganga Wildlife Sanctuary is at an approximate radial distance of 45.00 km. from area proposed for diversion.
- 3.6 Proposed area is not included in National Park, Wild Life Sanctuary or Nature Reserve.
- 3.7 Proposed Compensatory Afforestation over 18.18 ha. Non-Forest land at Village-Gundawal, Tehsil-Mahur, Range-Mahur Survey/Gut No.70. This area is suitable for afforestation and management purpose and also it is free from encroachment.
- 3.8 Proposed project is not likely to affect any monumental site of cultural, historical, religious, archeological or recreational importance.
- 3.9 The project is extremely site-specific and no alternative non-forest land can be used for the propose.
- 3.10 CA Scheme for Ten years.

### 4. The User Agency has submitted undertakings:-

- 4.1 to bear the cost of exploitation of felling of trees and their allied works in forest land.
- 4.2 to bear the cost of Compensatory afforestation.
- 4.3 to bear the cost of Net Present Value.
- 4.4 Whatever Penalties will be imposed regarding the violation of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 User Agency is ready to pay the same.
- 4.5 to submit compliance under FRA-2006.
- 5. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Maharashtra State, Nagpur has recommended the proposal subject to the conditions, given in his specific recommendations, under Section-2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. His specific recommendations are enclosed in the proposal.
- 6. In the circumstances explained in the aforesaid paragraphs and enclosures, the State Government recommends that the said forest land may be allowed to be diverted subject the conditions proposed by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Maharashtra State, Nagpur. The matter may kindly be placed before the Government of India for its approval under Section-2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, be obtained and communicated to this Government.
