Sub: Proposal for diversion of 0.5844 Ha. of forest land for laying of 66 KV Single Circuit Transmission Line from Singhik to Passingdong in North District of Sikkim by Energy & Power Department Government of Sikkim - In Principle Approval reg.

Sir,

Reference your No. FP/SK/TRANS/43552/2019 received through on-line/off line mode and after careful examination of your proposal, the State Govt. is hereby pleased to accord the Stage-I (In-Principle) Approval in terms of the General approval as conveyed by the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Govt of India, New Delhi under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act 1980 [vide letter No.F.No.11-9/98 FC, dated 03/01/2005 and Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2003 vide Chapter 4 para 4.3 category vide Sl. No. "c" — Electric line] for diversion of 0.5844 Ha. of forest land for laying of 66 KV Single Circuit Transmission Line from Singhik to Passingdong in North District of Sikkim by Energy & Power Department Government of Sikkim, subject to fulfillment of conditions as follows:

- (i) The User Agency shall transfer the cost of **Rs. 12,26,951.00** (Rupees twelve lakhs twenty six thousand nine hundred and fifty one) only for Compensatory Afforestation over double the degraded land of 1.1688 ha. identified at Pakshep Kazor under Mangan (T) Range, North (T) Division to the Adhoc CAMPA through State Forest Department.
- (ii) The User Agency shall transfer Rs. 4,08,496.00 (Rupees four lakhs eight thousand four hundred and ninety six) only for the Net Present Value (NPV) for the forest land diverted under this proposal as per the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India date 23.03.2008 & 09.05.2008 in IA No.566 in WP (C) No.202/1995 and as per the guideline issued by the Ministry vide letter No. 5-3/2007-FC dated 05/02/2009 in this regard.
- (iii) All the above funds along with the funds for **Rs. 66,304.00** (Rupees sixty six thousand three hundred and four) only for creation and maintenance of plantation of dwarf species in right of way under the transmission line as prepared by the concerned Division, shall be deposited in favour of the Secretary, Forests & Environment Department Govt. of Sikkim, Gangtok. Challan generated of e-portal. Payment details on generated of challan shall be mentioned
- (iv) Additional amount of NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, will be charged by the State Govt. from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
- (v) No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.

- (vi) The charges for felling, logging and transportation of project affected trees for Rs. 97,440.00 (Rupees ninety seven thousand four hundred and forty) only shall be deposited in favour of the Secretary, Forests & Environment Department Govt. of Sikkim, Gangtok.
- (vii) The expenditure like boundary walls, stone pillars, demarcation charges, cost of damage of trees the funds on these account should, be deposited with the DFO concerned.
- (viii) The user agency shall identify muck disposal site within Private Land as identified by the State Forest Department and prepare Muck Disposal Management Plan to be approved/agreed by the State Govt. for the aforesaid project proposal if required.
- (ix) The expenditure like boundary walls, stone pillars, demarcation charges, cost of damage of trees, the funds on these account should be deposited with the DFO concerned.
- (x) The user Agency shall obtain the Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, before consideration of final approval, if required.
- (xi) The user agency will have to obtain the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 clearance for stone, river sand, river boulder in forest land, if necessary.
- (xii) As per Ministry's letter No.11-30/96-FC (Pt) dated 14.09.2001, if the compliance of stipulated conditions is awaited from your department for more than 5(five) years, the In-Principle interested in the project.
- (xiii) The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/).

After fulfillment of the above conditions in completeness, the User agency shall submit the compliance report for seeking the Final Approval under General Approval under the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2003.

Diversion of forest land shall not be effected till the Final Approval is granted by the State Govt. in this respect. Demand Note in respect of Conditions No. (i) to (iii) & (vi) are also enclosed for realization of payment.

The IPA is issued within the delegated powers of the State Govt. as conveyed by the Ministry of Environment Forests & Climate Change, Govt. of India with the Guidelines, referred to above
