Kind attention of the Chief Engineer, Regional Officer, Govt. of India, Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Quality Control Building, Errum Manzil, Hyderabad is invited to the reference 1st cited above, wherein the Government of India, MoEF & Climate Change, Chennai accorded in principle (Stage-I) approval for diversion 4.399 Ha (Chennur-2.439 ha & Mancherial 2.020 ha (Revised from 1.960 Ha)) of forest land in Mancherial District for widening and strengthening from km 180/6 to Km 223/0 of Nizamabad to Jagadapur Section of NH-63 (old NH-16) with two lane paved shoulder in favour of CE-RO, GOI, MORTH, Hyderabad (User Agency).

Further, as per the Guidelines issued by the MoEF&CC, New Delhi, the user agency has to deposit all kind of levies towards NPV, CA etc in respective state CAMPAs account only through e-payment method by generating challan from the Ministry's web portal after approval of Nodal Officer (FCA) and to transfer funds against the Challan generated for the project and the charges towards cost of trees / tree felling / demarcation charges etc to be deposited into the Forest Divisional Officer account and the charges towards WL mitigation measures into BIOSOT account of Telangana State/ Adhoc-CAMPA account of the Telangana State. 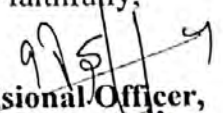

- The copies of the clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days from the date of receipt of this reference.

The transfer of forest land to User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final (Stage II) approval or working permission (for tree felling and execution of linear projects).

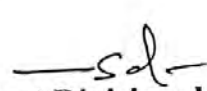
