Kind attention of the District Panchayath Raj Engineer, (PIU) Kumram Bheem Asifabad District, Asifabad is invited to the references cited above, vide reference 6<sup>th</sup> cited the Demand notice issued to the User Agency for the above subject/project and requested to deposit the cost of NPV, CA etc. through online mode into the Telangana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) bank account, by uploading the demand notice against the project for approval by the Nodal Officer (FCA) and generate challan after approval of demand notice. The payment has to be made against the number mentioned in the Challan number. A step-by step process for deposition of funds is available **at parivesh.nic.in** and also requested to intimate the details of payments made and submit **(8 sets)** of compliance report on all the conditions stipulated in Stage-I approval along with all the necessary documents, certificates, undertaking etc., for onwards submission to the competent authority for issue Stage-II approval.

But, till-to-date the User Agency has not submitting the condition wise compliance report on (Stage-I) approval along with remittance particulars of demand notice and required information/connected documents. Due to non-receipt of the same, a report to the higher authorities is held up.

The details of the demand notice issued vide reference 6<sup>th</sup> cited for extent of 0.400 Ha of **Kaghaznagar Division** is as follows.

Trees, planted in surrounding area, will belong to Forest department d) The cost of compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of rates as per compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in Adhoc CAMPA account by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.		
2	<b>Condition No. (iv): Net Present Value (NPV).</b>  a) The State Government shall charge Net Present value (NPV) for the <b>0.4000 ha</b> forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the User Agency as per the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated, 30/10/2002, 01/08/2003, 28/03/2008, 24/04/2008, and 09.05.2008 in IA. No. 566 in WP (C) No. 202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letter No. 5-1/1998-FC (pt. II) dated 18/09/2003, as well as letter No.5-2/2006-FC, Dt: 03/10/2006 and 5-3/200/-FC dated: 05/02/2009 in this regard. <b>(0.400 Ha x 6.260 lakhs per Ha)</b>	Rs. 2,50,400 =00	Deposition of amount in to the Adhoc CAMPA account of Telangana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority through the ministry's portal through E-payment mode.

3	<b>Condition No. (ii)</b> <b>Demarcation of the forest land diverted:</b> The State Forest Department shall carry out demarcation of the proposed fore area by erecting 4 feet high cement concrete pillars duly numbering at an interval of 20 meters at the cost of the User Agency and cost for which shall be deposited by the User Agency with the forest department as assessed by the concerned District Forest Officer / Forest Divisional Officer; <u>(As per circular No. 5/2017 Dated 13.09.2017.)</u>  a) <b>Big Pillars:</b> At entry and exit points of alignment of each notified forests, on the outer edge on the both sides, at one km interval and also at each change in directions of alignment in the forest. Total length of the road is 800 meters (Sirpur Range- 14 Nos @ Rs.12,000/- per each on the both sides (7 Nos x2 = 14 Nos).  b) <b>Small Pillars:</b> Fixing of pre-fabricated 4' re-enforced cement concrete (RCC) pillars above ground of 6"x 6" dimensions, on the outer edge on the both sides, @ every 20 m interval.( Sirpur Range-80 Nos @ Rs.1100/- per each on the both sides). (40 Nos x2 = 80 Nos). Further, the User Agency is once again requested comply with the following in accordance with the MoEF & CC, GoI instructions issued vide F.No.7-23-2012-FC, Dated: 24.07.2013 communicated vide PCCF., Hyderabad Rc.No.45921/2001/F4, Dt: 23.08.2013.

1. Publish the entire forest clearances granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purpose in verbatim along with the conditions and safeguards imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspaper i.e., one in vernacular language and the other in English.
2. The copies of the clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same for 30 days from the date of receipt of this reference.

The transfer of forest land to User agency **shall not be affected** prior to the issue of final approval (or) working permission whichever is earlier.

Early action is requested.
