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With reference to the subject and references cited above, it is informed that, in exercise of the powers delegated to the state Government by the Government of India, Ministry of Environment & Forests, New Delhi in the reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited above, the State Government vide G.O 6<sup>th</sup> cited above has accorded **in principle (Stage-I) approval** for diversion of **0.7506 Ha** of forest land for **improvement of existing road to BT Standard** from **8/600 of L028 to Chamanpally** of Vemanpally Mandal, Chennur RF of Chennur Forest Division of Mancheri District in favour of District Panchayath Raj Engineer (PIU) Mancheri (User Agency); which has been communicated by the Prl.Chief Conservator of Forests TS Hyderabad vide reference 7<sup>th</sup> cited and requested the DFOs/FDOs to raise the demand notice as per the actual rates and submit the demand notice to the nodal Officer for vetting. Further Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, TS Hyderabad has informed that only after vetting of the demand note by the Nodal officer, the District Forest Officer/Forest Divisional Officer should raise demand with the User Agency, who inturn has to upload the demand online on Ministry's portal, generate challan & transfer the funds through online only into the specified Ad-hoc CAMPA account of Telangana state. The detailed procedure for generation of Challan and deposition of funds is available at <https://parivesh.nic.in/> portal.

Accordingly, the assessment are made towards issuing of Demand Notice to the User Agency is furnished hereunder.

The User Agency shall deposit an amount of **Rs.4,61,600/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Sixty one thousand Six hundred only)** in favour of Forest Divisional Officer, Chennur PD A/c No. 62490360405 State Bank of India, Branch: Chennur, IFSC: SBIN0020128.

Further, the User Agency also requested that, the user agency shall compulsorily deposit an amount of **Rs. 13.1511 Lakhs** pertains to NPV, into Telangana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) saving bank Account through the Ministry's Website i.e., <http://parivesh.nic.in> by generating the challan in consultation with the Nodal Officer (FCA) O/o Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, TS, Hyderabad. The user agency needs to upload the demand notice against the project for approval by Nodal Officer (FCA), Telangana and generate challan after approval. The payment to be made against the Challan number and the Challan is valid for one week. A step-by-step process is available at <http://parivesh.nic.in>. The details of funds to be deposited into Adhoc CAMPA Account of Telangana are as follows:

Further, the User Agency will be requested to intimate the details of payments made and submit seven sets of compliance report on all the conditions stipulated in Stage-I approval along with all the necessary documents, certificates, undertaking etc., for onwards submission to the competent authority for issue Stage-II approval.

The User Agency is requested to comply with the following accordance with the Government of India instructions issued vide F.No.7-23/2012-FC, Dt.24.07.2013 communicated vide PCCF's Rc.No.45921/2001-F4, Dt.23.08.2013 and publish the orders at the cost of the project proponent.

1. Publish the entire forest clearance granted in verbatim along with the conditions and safe-guards imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily newspapers, one in vernacular language and the other in English language, so as to make people aware of the permission granted to the project proponent for use of forest land for non-forest purpose.
2. The copies of the Forest Clearance should also be submitted to the Head of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal Bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same in 30 days from the date of receipt of this reference.

Further, the User Agency will be requested to furnish undertakings on C. No. i,v,vi,vii viiii, ix, x, xi, xii, xiii, xiv, xv, xvii, xviii, xix, xx, xxi, xxii, xiii, xxiv,xxv, xxvi & xxviii.

The transfer of forest land to User Agency shall not be affected prior to the issue of final (Stage II) approval or working permission.

In view of the above, it is requested to kindly accord permission to raise the above demand notice to the user agency.
