The **Regional Officer, MoRTH, Hyderabad**, is requested to deposit the Compensatory levies towards CA, NPV etc., into the Telangana State Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) through online mode only, through e-portal method at MoEF&CC, GOI, New Delhi portal i.e., <http://parivesh.nic.in> by generating the challan in consultation with Nodal Officer, Telangana State Forest Department. The user agency needs to upload the Demand Notice against the project for approval by Nodal Officer (FCA), Telangana and generate challan after approval. Further, the user agency has to comply with the following in accordance with the instructions issued by the GoI, MOEF&CC, New Delhi Vide F.No.7-23-2012-FC, Dated. 24.07.2013 communicated vide PCCF's Ref.No.45921/2001/F4, Dated. 23.08.2013.

1. Publish the entire forest clearances granted to the project proponent for the use of forest land for the non-forest purposes in verbatim along with the condition(s) and safe-guards imposed by the Central Government in two widely circulated daily news paper i.e., one is vernacular language and the other in English.

2. The copies of the forest clearance should also be submitted to the heads of local bodies, Panchayats and municipal bodies by the project proponents in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in-turn has to display the same for (30) days from the date of receipt of this reference.
3. The user agency should prepare and handover the left out portion of old road (0.42 Ha) by removing the existing block top, leveling etc., to raise plantation at the cost of the user agency.

The User Agency is requested to comply with the other conditions as directed in Stage-I approval and submit the compliance report along with all the required relevant information/documents etc. for obtaining Stage-I approval.
