Sanction Order of the Wildlife Management Plan for diversion of 54.407 ha. of forest land in favour of Jharkhand Urja Sancharan Nigam Ltd. (JUSNL) for construction of 132 KV D/C Jamua-Gawan Transmission Line under Giridih East & West Forest Division in Giridih districts of Jharkhand.

The Wildlife Management Plan (referred to as "the Instant Plan" hereinafter) has been prepared by Jharkhand Urja Sancharan Nigam Ltd. (JUSNL) (referred to as "the User Agency" or "JUSNL" hereinafter) in pursuance of the Condition laid under Item no. A(3) of the "in-principle" (Stage-I) approval order issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India, Regional Office, Ranchi vide its letter no. FP/JH/TRANS/ 45077/2020/38 dated 16.01.2025 for diversion of 54.407 ha. of forest land in favour of Jharkhand Urja Sancharan Nigam Ltd. (JUSNL) for construction of 132 KV D/C Jamua-Gawan Transmission Line under Giridih East & West Forest Division in Giridih districts of Jharkhand.

The aforesaid condition laid by the Central Government reads as follows:

"A.(3). The User Agency should prepare and implement Site-specific Wildlife Management Plan at their Project Cost in consultation and under the guidance of local forest official and implement it in a time bound manner through SFD."

In the above stated background, the Addl. Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Bokaro (APCCF, Bokaro) vide his letter no. 684 dated 24.04.2025 has submitted the Plan to the office of the undersigned for its due sanction. While considering the plan for its approval, a Power Point Presentation (PPT) was scheduled with APCCF, Bokaro; DFO, Giridih West Forest Division & DFO, Giridih East Forest Division in the office of undersigned, on dated 15.05.2025. The PPT was attended by CCF, Wildlife, Jharkhand; DFO, Giridih West Forest Division; Shree Praween Kumar, Executive Director (Project), JUSNL; Shree Biswarup Kar, Executive Engineer, JUSNL and Shree Shibdas Dhar, Junior Engineer, JUSNL.

The Plan contains five chapters including Introduction and Background of the project, Potential project impacts on Environment and Wildlife, Management objective and mitigation strategies, Interventions to be done within the project site & Detailed cost sheet for project and project impact area.

Wildlife Management Plan suggests "Mitigation Measures" to the actions that can be implemented to minimize the magnitude of the project related detrimental impacts on ecology in general and forests & wildlife of the project area. The activities/management interventions have been proposed in Giridih West & East Forest Division.

The various work components have been assigned to the implementing agencies so as to achieve the maximum efficiency in terms of output and to the best of appreciation of the needs of conservation of forests and wildlife.

The summary of the proposed interventions (component wise) under the Plan with the objective of conservation of forests and wildlife resources as also to mitigate the impacts of Linear Infrastructure on forests and wildlife is as follows:

The Plan with a total financial outlay of Rs. 538.853 lakhs; Rs. 95.820 lakhs for implementation of Plan extending over a period of 5 years (Year 2025-26 to 2029-30; tentatively), shall be utilized by the State Forest Department through the DFO, Giridih West Forest Division and of Rs. 443.033 lakhs for implementation of Plan extending over a period of 10 years (Year 2025-26 to 2034-35; tentatively), shall be utilized by the State Forest Department through the DFO, Giridih East Forest Division in accordance with the Plan prescriptions.

Considering the proposals under the plan, sanction is hereby accorded to the instant Plan subject to the following conditions:

- (i) That various activities in the project shall be executed under the monitoring and guidance of DFO, Giridih West Forest Division and DFO, Giridih East Forest Division in its jurisdiction and under the supervision of APCCF, Bokaro and CF, Territorial Circle, Giridih.

- (ii) That the User Agency shall ensure that its officials/contractors and the work forces engaged into transmission line laying and allied works shall not commit or abet any forest/ wildlife offence in their area of operation. They will also promptly report any forest/ wildlife offence in the area to the nearest forest office/ official. Further, they will extend their full co-operation to the forest officials in control/ mitigation of any incident, natural or man-made, detrimental to forest and wildlife in their area of operation.
- (iii) In the cases of management of lands of Protected Areas/ forests under transmission lines (condition no. A(3) of forest clearance Stage-I) will be followed while implementing of the project and with special considerations for protecting elephants from accidental electrocution by keeping height above ground at the lowest point of the lowest conductor or grounding wires (i.e. at maximum sag point) of power lines and also to avoid electrocution to avifauna and other arboreal species.
- (iv) The entire length of the proposed power line should be marked with appropriate Bird Flight Diverters (BFD) spaced at 10 m intervals. Line marker devices to increase visibility of the earth wires at the top of the Transmission line should be used at 10 m to reduce bird collision. The Bird Flight Diverters (BFD) shall be regularly checked and maintained by the User Agency.
- (v) The User Agency and project personnel will comply with the provisions of Standard SOP/ Guidelines issued by WII, Dehradun for linear projects.
- (vi) Any felling/ pollarding/ pruning of trees for allowing electrical clearance/ maintenance will be done with the permission of the DFO, Giridih West Forest Division and DFO, Giridih East Forest Division in its jurisdictions. Only those trees that are of sufficient height to compromise the requirements of minimal vertical and horizontal clearance from the conductor wires at maximum sag point should be lopped.
- (vii) That the total amount of Rs. 538.853 lakhs (Rupees Five crore thirty eight lakhs eighty five thousand three hundred only) shall be deposited by the User Agency into CAMPA account only through <https://parivesh.nic.in> under the relevant head/ sub-head which shall be utilized by the State Forest Department through the DFO, Giridih West Forest Division and DFO, Giridih East Forest Division as delineated under this Plan, strictly in accordance with the prevailing norms under the Jharkhand Forest Department.
- (viii) That the User Agency shall implement the mitigation measures/ activities mentioned under the Plan. The implementation shall be done under the directions and strict supervisions of DFO, Giridih West Forest Division and DFO, Giridih East Forest Division.
- (ix) That the DFO, Giridih West Forest Division and DFO, Giridih East Forest Division shall prepare detailed Annual Plans of Operations (APOs) in the beginning of every financial year during the Plan period, as provided in the instant Plan, following all the rules, regulations, Schedule of Rates etc. issued from time to time by the State Government/ Forest Department. APCCF, Bokaro in case of DFO, Giridih West Forest Division and DFO, Giridih East Forest Division shall accord sanctions to the said APOs following due process and they will respectively closely monitor the

implementation/ progress of the activities undertaken by Giridih West Forest Division and Giridih East Forest Division as per directions issued by the Forest Department from time to time.

- (x) That the DFO, Giridih West Forest Division and DFO, Giridih East Forest Division shall carry out the activities under the Plan strictly as per the duly sanctioned APOs.
- (xi) That the CF, Territorial Circle, Giridih shall supervise all the activities under the Plan undertaken by Giridih West Forest Division and Giridih East Forest Division as per directions issued by the Forest Department from time to time.
- (xii) That the DFO, Giridih West Forest Division and DFO, Giridih East Forest Division shall ensure that no violation of duly sanctioned Working Plan of Giridih West Forest Division and Giridih East Forest Division takes place during implementation of any of the activities involved in this plan over notified and demarcated forest land.
- (xiii) That the instant Plan is dynamic and shall be revisited after every 2 years and a revised plan may be formulated as per need of the project impacted area and convenience of the implementing agencies. The revised plan, if any, shall be put up before the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Wildlife & Chief Wildlife Warden, Jharkhand for its due approval.
- (xiv) That the User Agency shall submit an Undertaking to the DFO, Giridih West Forest Division and DFO, Giridih East Forest Division to the effect that they will deposit extra cost of the plan owing to increase in wage rate, cost of materials etc. in due course of time as well as consequent upon revision of the plan, if any, as and when given effect to by the competent authority.
