Sub: APFD- F(C) Act,1980- Diversion of 5.60Ha. of Forest land in Compartment No.182 , R.H.R.F Extn-II, Chintur Range, Chintur Division for formation & BT to the road including construction of culverts from Lakkavaram to Kansuluru in favour of Executive Engineer, PR(PIU) Division, Kakinada - In-Principal (Stage-I) approval accorded-Revised Demand notice issued- Reg.

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It is to inform that, the Government of India in the reference 1stcited, have accorded In-principal approval (Stage-I)u/s 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 5.60 Ha. of Forest land in Compartment No.182 ,R.H.R.F Extn-II, Chintur Range of Chintur Division for formation & BT to the road including construction of culvertsfrom Chintur to Lakkavaram viaKansuluru, Chadhalawada village, Chintur in favour of the Executive Engineer, PR(PIU) Division, Kakinada by duly stipulating certain conditions to be complied as communicated by the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, A.P., Guntur vide reference 2ndcited. Accordingly, a Demand notice was raised before the concerned User Agency for payment of Compensatory levies and for furnishing of condition wise compliance stipulated in Stage-I approval by the Government of the India.

Subsequently, as per the condition no.(xiii) in Stage-I (In-Principal) approval, the site specific wildlife mitigation plan was prepared and submitted to the competent authority for approvalin the references 4th and 5th cited. Now, the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests, (WL) & Chief Wildlife Warden, A.P., Guntur has approved the Wildlife Mitigation Plan and communicated in the reference 6th cited. Hence, the Demand notice already issued from this office in the reference 4th cited is hereby revised for payment of the following Compensatory levies by the User Agency through e-payment mode as per the guidelines issued by the Ad-hoc CAMPA, New Delhi letter dated: 09-06-2016 and as per the guidelines issued in GoI, MoEF&CC(FC Division) F.No.5-3/2011-FC(Vol-I), Dt.06.01.2022.The details of the payments should be paid by the User Agency are as follows:-

Amount demanded to be deposited in Adhoc CAMPA, Corporation Bank, Lodhi Road, New Delhi through e-Challan only.(As per IGF, Ad-hoc, CAMPA Lr.No.12-2/2010-CAMPa, dated: 09-06-2016 communicated vide PCCF's Rc.No.45921/2001/FCA-4 (i), dated: 04-07-2016)

1.(a) Procedure for e- challan generation:

- i) On issue of this notice, the user agency shall log in to Forest Clearance portal **forests clearance.nic.in/www.parivesh.nic.in** to generate e-challan and make payment against the demand.
- ii) Agency shall fill all the details as per the format provided in the portal and submit to Nodal Officer for verification.
- iii) Once it is verified by Nodal Officer, Agency can generate e-challan from the portal

1.(b) Procedure for Payment through RTGS :

- iv) For payment through RTGS, the representation of the agency should visit his bank branch (RTGS enabled) of a Bank of his choice along with printed e-challan with an Account Number printed on it.
 - v) While tendering the e-challan at the bank, the agency must ensure that the unique account number mentioned in the challan should be correctly mentioned as the account number in which funds to be remitted.
 - vi) Upon executing the RTGS by the sender/remitter bank, the amount collected will be credited to relevant CAMPA state account with the Bank on real time basis.
- II. **Amount demanded for Tree extraction, logging and transportation in the forest area diverted to be deposited with Divisional Forest Officer**(As per IGF, Ad-hoc, CAMPA Lr.No.12-2/2010-CAMPA, dated : 09-06-2016 communicated vide PCCF,s Rc.No.45921/2001/FCA-4 (i), dated: 04-07-2016)



It is further informed that, as per the Condition No.(xi) in Stage-I (In-Principal) approval, at the cost of User Agency, forest department shall establish forest check posts at the entry and exit points of the road before formation of road as proposed by the Divisional Forest Officer. **Hence, it is requested to deposit Rs. 10.00 Lakhs (2 Nos. x Rs. 5.00 lakh per each) amount in Divisional Forest Officer, Chintur State Bank of India Account No. 62404979187 (Yerrampeta Branch, Chintur & IFSC Code: SBIN0020693)** for establishment of check posts at the entry and exit points of the proposed road.

In addition to the above, as per the conditions mentioned in approved wildlife mitigation plan, the constructions of a Box Culvert and Chain- link for crossing of wild animals with a financial outlay of Rs.35.00 Lakhs should be executed by the User Agency with their own cost duly incorporating in the project cost.

Further, it is informed that if any payment is made by any other method, the same shall not considered for compliance towards Stage I/II and also submit the payment receipts along with the compliance report to the each and every condition stipulated in In-principal approval (Stage-I) along with documents/ undertaking certificates to this office without fail for taking further action in this matter.
