Sub: Forests – Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 – Dindigul Circle / Karur Division - Proposal (FP/TN/Water/153702/2022) for diversion of forest land of 0.874 ha for construction of foot bridges for collector well 4 & 5 and MV Panel room for Collector well 5 and construction of headworks under Combined Water Supply Scheme to 8 Town Panchayats, 2452 Rural Habitations, 3 Municipalities in Sivaganga District across Maruthur Reserved Forest in favour of Assistant Engineer, Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board, Kulithalai – Regarding.

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I am directed to enclose a copy of the reference cited and to state that, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force) in his letter cited has stated that, the Assistant Engineer, Tamilnadu Water Supply and Drainage Board, Kulithalai has uploaded online forest area diversion proposal under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of forest land of 0.874 ha for construction of foot bridges for collector well 4&5 and MV Panel room for Collector well 5 and construction of headworks under Combined Water Supply Scheme to 8 Town Panchayats, 2452 Rural Habitations, 3 Municipalities in Sivaganga District across Maruthur Reserved Forest in favour of Assistant Engineer, Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board, Kulithalai

2. In the Part-II of Form-A, the District Forest Officer, Karur has furnished the following particulars :-

- i) Area to be diverted for the above proposal is 0.874 ha to a density of zero and type of forest is Eco class-4.

- ii) The details of wildlife present in and around the forest land proposed for diversion is Peacock, Mongoose, Hare, Crane etc.
- iii) The proposed area does not form part of National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant Corridor, Wildlife Migration Corridor.
- iv) The proposed area is not located within Eco Sensitive Zone of the protected area notified under Wildlife (Protection) Act 1972.
- v) The forest land proposed for diversion is not located within 1km from the boundary of National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant Corridor, and Wildlife Migration Corridor.
- vi) No rare / endangered / unique species of Flora and Fauna found in the proposed area.
- vii) No protected archeological / heritage site / defense establishment or any other important monument is located in the area.
- viii) No work in violation of the Act or guidelines issued under the act.
- ix) The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency is unavoidable and bare minimum for the project.
- x) Under species-wise and girth wise enumeration of trees of Eucalyptus trees of 942 Nos. were enumerated. There is no spontaneous growth of trees found in the proposed project area.
- xi) In section 13, Details of Compensatory Afforestation, under patch wise details, Compensatory Afforestation scheme to an amount of Rs. 99.44 lakhs uploaded for planting of 9420 nos. of plants including 10 years maintenance in degraded forest area in lieu of felling of 942 planted Eucalyptus trees for this project. The degraded area of 47 ha is selected for planting in D-Edaiyapatty Bit-III Reserved Forest in Karur Range. The District Forest Officer, Karur has also uploaded the suitability certificate for the above land selected for planting. The KML file also uploaded.

3. In the site inspection report, the District Forest Officer, Karur has inspected the proposed project site on 02.06.2022 and stated the following details :-

The components of works proposed in the area are

- a. For Construction of Footbridge No.1 for laying pipeline in a linear stretch of Reserved Forest land to a length of 330 meters and width of 3.50 meters (1No x 330m x 3.50m = 0.1155 Ha.) in Marudhur Reserved Forest.
- b. For construction of Footbridge No.2 for laying pipeline in a linear stretch of Reserved Forest land to a length of 160 meters and width of 3.50 meters (1No x 160m x 3.50m = 0.0560 Ha.) in Marudhur Reserved Forest.
- c. For construction of the M.V.Panel room is a polygon stretch of Reserved Forest land to a length of 5.00 meters and width of 5.00 meters (1No x 5m x 5m = 0.0025 Ha.) in Marudhur Reserved Forest.

- d. For construction of Head works components (Collection Sump-38.85 LL capacity, Sump cum pump house-5.00 LL capacity, MCC room 15m x 9m, Transformer yard, Staff Quarters and Office Building) is a polygon stretch of Reserved Forest land to a length of 140 meters and width of 50 meters (1No x 140m x 50m = 0.7000 Ha.) in Marudhur Reserved Forest.

Hence the total proposed area is 0.8740 Ha.
(0.1155 Ha+0.0560 Ha+0.0025 Ha+0.7000 Ha)

4. He has further stated that the area proposed for diversion by the user agency is very minimum and there is no alternative land for the proposed project except the forest land. The user agency has not started any work in the proposed site inside the Marudhur Reserved Forest. Therefore the question of violation of provision in Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for this proposal does not arise. There is no rare / endangered / unique species of flora and fauna in the Marudhur Reserved Forest. Eucalyptus coppice and Prosopis juliflora were present in the proposed project area. Tamil Nadu Forest Plantation Corporation Limited also planted Eucalyptus Saplings during 2021-22 in some of the areas proposed by the Tamilnadu Water Supply and Drainage Board. There is no protected archaeological/ heritage site/ defence establishment and there is no monuments in the above project site. The user agency has wrongly mentioned the Reserved Forest name in the proposal as Marudhur North Reserved Forest/ Marudhur North-1 Reserved Forest instead of Marudhur Reserved Forest.

5. Further, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force) has stated that in the recommendation of the project proposal, the District Forest Officer has stated that,

- a) The user agency has submitted the necessary undertaking on Compensatory Afforestation expenditure, Net Present Value, Additional Net Present Value, Cost of felling of trees and Annual Lease Rent.
- b) Eucalyptus coppice raised by Tamil Nadu Forest Plantation Corporation Limited and Prosopis juliflora in natural was present in the proposed project area. Tamil Nadu Forest Plantation Corporation Limited has also planted Eucalyptus Saplings during 2021-22 in some of the areas proposed for the project by the Tamilnadu Water Supply and Drainage Board. For which, an amount of Rs.3,30,134/- was raised as demand by the Regional Manager, Tamil Nadu Forest Plantation Corporation Limited, Pudukkottai to the above said Eucalyptus plantation and Eucalyptus coppice on the field and also requested the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Forest Plantation Corporation Limited, Trichy to approve the amount demanded as compensation by him.
- c) The Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board may be asked to remit the compensation amount demanded by the Regional Manager, Tamil Nadu Forest Plantation Corporation Limited, Pudukkottai (or) the amount approved/fixed by the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Forest Plantation Corporation Limited, Trichy as compensation.
- d) This diversion is proposed for a project which may reduce the water scarcity in 8 Town Panchayats, 2452 Rural Habitations in 11 Panchayat Unions with bulk provision to 3 Municipalities in Sivagangai District. Diversion of the particular stretch may not cause much disturbance to wildlife and it will not adversely affect the ecosystem.

Taking into consideration the facts stated above, the District Forest Officer, Karur has recommended for diversion of 0.874 Ha of Forest land in Marudhur Reserved Forest.

6. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force) has further stated that the Chief Conservator of Forests, Dindigul has inspected the proposed area for diversion on 20.06.2022 and agreed the informations made by the District Forest Officer. The Chief Conservator of Forests, Dindigul has recommended the proposed area for diversion of 0.874 ha since the project meant to provide drinking water to 2452 habitations.

7. Further, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force) has stated that the forest area required for diversion for this project is 0.874 Ha only (i.e) less than 1 ha. However, it involves felling of 942 nos. of trees. Hence this project proposal cannot be considered by the State Government under General approval category as per Chapter 4.2 of Hand book of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and Forest Conservation Rules 2003 and requires approval of Government of India.

8. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has stated that, the proposal is sent duly recommended by the Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Forest (Conservation) Act / Nodal Officer, Forest (Conservation) Act.

9. Based on the recommendations made by the District Forest Officer, Karur Forest Division, Karur, Chief Conservator of Forests, Dindigul Circle, Dindigul and Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Forest Conservation Act), the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has recommended the proposal for diversion of 0.874 ha of forest land in Maruthur Reserve Forest of Karur Forest Division for construction of foot bridges for collector well 4&5 and MV Panel room for Collector well 5 and construction of headworks under Combined Water Supply Scheme to 8 Town Panchayats, 2452 Rural Habitations, 3 Municipalities in Sivaganga District in favour of Assistant Engineer, Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board, Kulithalai for a period of 50 years, under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act 1980 and requested the Government to forward the same to the Government of India for obtaining Stage-I approval for the project proposal, subject to the following conditions:-

- I. The legal status of the land shall remain unchanged and shall remain as Reserved Forests.
- II. The demarcation of the proposed forest area shall be carried out by erecting 4 feet height cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 mts at the cost of User Agency.
- III. The pipeline shall be laid down 1.5m below the ground after laying down of pipeline the ground will be leveled.
- IV. The User Agency shall remit Compensatory Afforestation amount as demanded by the Forest Department.
- V. The Compensatory Afforestation shall be raised in the degraded forest area in D.Edaiyapatty Bit-III RF to an area of 47 ha.
- VI. The User Agency shall pay the Net present value of the diverted forest area at the rates stipulated by the Ministry of Environment and Forests in File.No:5-3/2011-FC (Vol.I) dated 06.01.2022 and 19.01.2022 and from time to time, as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 28.03.2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA Nos. 826 in 566 with related IAs in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995.

- VII. The fund from the User Agency towards Compensatory Afforestation and Net Present Value under this project shall be deposited by generating chalan from the Ministry's online web portal. UTR No and date should be furnished.
- VIII. The Additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to the effect.
- IX. The User Agency shall be responsible for any loss to Flora and Fauna in the surroundings and shall take all possible measures to conserve the same.
- X. The forest land shall not be used for any other purpose other than that specified in the proposal.
- XI. The lease rent should be realized from the User Agency as per G.O.Ms.No.272, Environment and Forests (FR.XIII) Department, dated 15.04.1991.
- XII. The period of lease is 50 years.
- XIII. The User Agency should send renewal proposal one year before expiry of lease.
- XIV. The Conservator of Forests and District Forest Officer may impose any other condition in the interest of conservation / protection / and development of forests.
- XV. The Compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal.

10. The Government have examined and accept the proposal (FP/TN/Water/153702/2022) of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force) for diversion of 0.874 ha of forest land in Maruthur Reserve Forest of Karur Forest Division for construction of foot bridges for collector well 4 & 5 and MV Panel room for Collector well 5 and construction of headworks under Combined Water Supply Scheme to 8 Town Panchayats, 2452 Rural Habitations, 3 Municipalities in Sivaganga District in favour of Assistant Engineer, Tamilnadu Water Supply and Drainage Board, Kulithalai for a period of 50 years, under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act 1980 and decided to forward the same to Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, Government of India for obtaining their concurrence.

11. I am, therefore, directed to request you to kindly obtain the concurrence of the Competent Authority and communicate the same to this Government, early.

11) The proposal is sent herewith duly recommended in the part IV of Form A by the Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (FCA) / Nodal Officer (Forest Conservation Act).

12) The area proposed for diversion of 0.874ha Ha for construction of foot bridges for collector well 4&5 and MV Panel room for Collector well 5 and construction of headworks under Combined Water Supply Scheme to 8 Town Panchayats, 2452 Rural Habitations, 3 Municipalities in Sivaganga District across Maruthur Reserved Forest is recommended and forwarded to the Government of Tamilnadu for consideration and to obtain Stage I approval from the Government of India subject to the following conditions.

- IV. The User Agency shall remit Compensatory Afforestation amount as demanded by the Forest Department.
- V. The Compensatory Afforestation shall raise in the degraded forest area in D.Edaiyapatty Bit-III RF to an area of 47ha.
- VI. The User Agency shall pay the Net present value of the diverted forest area at the rates stipulated by the Ministry of Environment and Forests in File.No:5-3/2011-FC (Vol.I) dated 06.01.2022 and 19.01.2022 and from time to time, as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dated 28.03.2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA Nos. 826 in 566 with related IAS in Writ Petition(Civil) No.202/1995.
- VII. The fund from the User Agency towards Compensatory Afforestation and NPV under this project shall be deposited by generating chalan from the Ministry's online web portal. UTR No and date should be furnished.
- VIII. The Additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to the effect.
- IX. The User Agency shall be responsible for any loss to Flora and Fauna in the surroundings and shall take all possible measures to conserve the same.
- X. The forest land shall not be used for any other purpose other than that specified in the proposal.

- XI. The lease rent should be realized from the User Agency as per G.O.Ms.No.272, E&F(FR.XIII) Dept. dated 15.04.1991.
 - XII. The period of lease is 50 years.
 - XIII. The User Agency should send renewal proposal one year before expiry of lease.
 - XIV. The Conservator of Forests and District Forest Officer may impose any other condition in the interest of conservation /protection land development of forests.
 - XV. The Compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal.

I request that necessary Stage I approval for diversion of 0.874ha forest land in Maruthur Reserve Forest of Karur Forest Division for construction of foot bridges for collector well 4&5 and MV Panel room for Collector well 5 and construction of headworks under Combined Water Supply Scheme to 8 Town Panchayats, 2452 Rural Habitations, 3 Municipalities in Sivaganga District may be accorded under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 in favour of Assistant Engineer, TWAD Board, Kulithalai for a period of 50 years.
