Sub : Proposal for diversion of 0.24 Ha. of forest land for construction of link road from NH 10 (near Old India Press) via Gurung Crematorium towards ICDS and Gurung Gaon in Burtuk, East Sikkim by Roads & Bridges Department, Govt. of Sikkim - In Principle approval reg.

Sir,

Reference your [No. FP/SK/ROAD/38789/2019 received through on-line/off line mode and after careful examination of your proposal, the State Govt. is hereby pleased to accord the **stage-I (In-Principle) Approval** in terms of the General approval as conveyed by the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Govt of India, New Delhi under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act 1980 [vide letter No.F.No.11-9/98 FC, dated 03/01/2005 and subsequently letter No.F.No.11-9/98-FC dated 13/2/2014] for **diversion of 0.24 Ha. of forest land for construction of link road from NH 10 (near Old India Press) via Gurung Crematorium towards ICDS and Gurung Gaon in Burtuk, East Sikkim by Roads & Bridges Department, Govt. of Sikkim**, subject to fulfillment of following conditions :--


- (1) The User Agency shall transfer the cost of **Rs. 1,11,427.00** (Rupees one lakhs eleven thousand four hundred and twenty seven) only for Compensatory Afforestation (Block Plantation) over double the area in degraded forest land i.e. 0.48 ha identified at Yali RF under Gangtok Range under East Territorial Division.
- (2) The User Agency shall pay and transfer the payment of **Rs. 1,57,680.00** (Rupees one lakhs fifty seven thousand six hundred and eighty) only for Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land being diverted for the project proposal as per the Order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 28/03/2008, 24/04/2008 and 09/05/2008 in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 202/1995 and the guidelines issued by this Ministry vide letter No. 5-3/2007-FC dated 05/02/2009 in this regard.
- (3) At the time of payment of the Net present Value (NPV) at the present rate, the User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per final decision of the same by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
- (4) All the above funds (CA cost, NPV etc) shall be deposited in favor of the Principal PCCF-cum-Pr. Secretary, Forests Environment & Wildlife Management Department Govt. of Sikkim, Gangtok for onward deposition under State Compensatory Afforestation Fund under Major Head " 8336-Civil Deposit MIH-103-SCAD as per recent guidelines.
- (5) The User Agency shall bear and deposit the amount of the cost of demarcation of the land proposed for diversion directly to the concerned Divisional Forest Officer. The concerned Divisional Forest Officer shall demarcate the land proposed for diversion on the ground by erecting at least 4' high cement-concrete pillars duly numbered, forward and backward bearing and distance from pillars to pillars written on the pillars and DGPS co-ordinates to be inscribed on the pillars. The competent authority shall verify and issue a certificate to this effect. Photographs showing permanent boundary pillars with GPS co-ordinates to be submitted.

- (6) No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- (7) The charges for felling, logging and transportation of project affected trees for **Rs. 2,17,705.00** (Rupees two lakhs seventeen thousand seven hundred and five) only shall be paid by the User Agency at the rates approved by the State Govt. and deposited separately in favor of the Principal PCCF-cum-Pr. Secretary, Forests Environment & Wildlife Management Department Govt. of Sikkim, Gangtok.
- (8) The expenditure like boundary walls, stone pillars, demarcation charges, cost of damage of trees the funds on these account should, be deposited with the DFO concerned.
- (9) The user Agency shall obtain the Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, before consideration of final approval, if required.
- (10) The user agency will have to obtain the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 clearance for stone, river sand, river boulder in forest land, if necessary.
- (11) As per Ministry's letter No.11-30/96-FC (Pt) dated 14.09.2001, if the compliance of stipulated conditions is awaited from the State Government for more than 5(five) years the in-principle approval would summarily be revoked considering that the user agency is no longer interested in the project.

After fulfillment of the above conditions in completeness, the User agency shall submit the **compliance report** for seeking the Final Approval under General Approval under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 by the State Govt. **Diversion of forest land shall not be effected till the Final Approval is granted by the State Govt. in this respect. Demand Note in respect of Conditions No. (1), (2) & (7) are also enclosed for realization of payment.**

This issued within the delegated powers of the State Govt. as conveyed by the Ministry of Environment Forests & Climate Change, Govt. of India with the Guidelines, referred to above.
