**TO WHOM SOEVER IT MAY CONCERN**

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2009 ('FRA' for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purpose read with MoEF's letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> February 2013 wherein MoEF issued, it is certified that 0.018 Hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of the Superintendent of Police, Theni District, Theni that for the construction of Police Checkpost at Kumuly for an area of 180 Sq.m. (or) 0.018 Ha. land which is available in Suranganar RF of Cumbum West Range in Theni Forest Division falls within jurisdiction of Uthamapalayam Tahsils.

It is further certified that :

- (a) The Complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 0.018 Hectares of forest land proposed for diversion.
- (b) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under Section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Police Department have their consent to it.
- (c) The proposal does not involve recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural Communities.
