Cart-tracks in this sheet are generally notifiable (four-wheel drive).

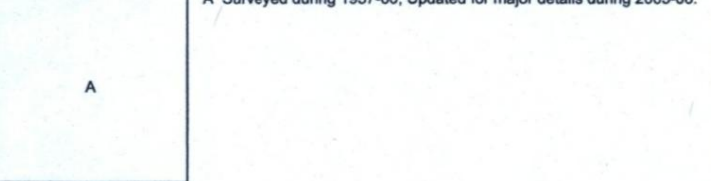
Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to April.
