In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (Pt.) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidence for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA' for short) on the Forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects it is certified that 4.88 Hectares of Forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of I & CAD department Pulikanuma L.I.Scheme for the excavation of link canal from Pulikanuma reservoir to the existing TBP LLC canal under Pulikanuma Lift Irrigation Scheme in Kuppagallu Reserved Forest in Adoni Range in Kurnool Dist falls within jurisdiction of Kosigi village(s) in Kosigi tehsils.

It is further certified that

- a) The complete process for identification and settlement of right under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 4.88 hectares of forest land proposed for diversion. A copy record of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as Annexure I to Annexure II.
- b) The proposals of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Grama Sabhas have their consent to it.
- c) The proposal does not involve recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre agricultural communities.

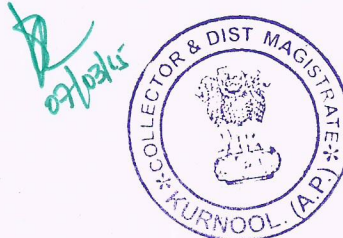
In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (Pt.) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidence for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA' for short) on the Forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that 4.88 hectares of Forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of I&CAD Department, Pulikanuma Lift Irrigation Scheme in Kurnool Dist, for the excavation of link canal from Pulikanuma reservoir to the existing TBP LLC canal under Pulikanuma Lift Irrigation Scheme in Kuppagallu Reserved Forest in Adoni Range in Kurnool Dist falls within jurisdiction of Kuppagal village(s) in Kosigi tehsils.

It is further certified that

- a) The complete process for identification and settlement of right under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 4.88 hectares of Forest land proposed for diversion and found that no traditional forest dwellers are living in the area and nobody is depending on this Forest. A copy record of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as Annexure I to Annexure II.
- b) The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular / local language) have been placed before concerned Gram Sabha of forest dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA.
- c) The concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities / Processes under the FRA have been carried out and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understand the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy certificate issued by the Gram Sabha of Peddathumbalam village(s) is enclosed as Annexure I to Annexure II.
- d) The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present.
- e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their consent to it.
- f) The right of primitive Tribal groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3 (I) (e) of the FRA.

**STATEMENT SHOWING CERTIFICATES FROM A TO H**

A.	A letter from the State Government certifying that the complete process for identification and settlement of right under the FRA has been carried out for the entire forest area proposed for diversion, with a record of all consultations and meetings held.	The proposed area for diversion in kuppagallu RF of Adoni Range Kurnool Dist does not fall in the Scheduled Tribes area and therefore does not attract the provisions of RoFR Act,2006. Consequent on which, identification and settlement of rights under FRA does not arise.
B.	A letter from the State Government certifying that proposals for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular / Local languages) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of Forest-Dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA.	There are no Forest Dwellers in the proposed diversion area, hence, does not arise.
C.	A letter from each of the concerned Gram Sabhas, indicating that all formalities / Processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensatory and ameliorative measures if any, having understood the purpose and details of processed diversion.	The Resolution passed in the Gram panchayat was obtained from the Peddathumbalam village of Adoni Mandal of Kurnool District duly conducting meeting and required documents / certificates giving their consent to the proposed diversion are submitted. However, there are no claims existing in the area proposed for diversion.
D.	A letter from the State Government certifying that the diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under Section 3(2) of the FRA have been complied and that the Gram Sabha have consented to.	Does not arise, as the proposed forest land for diversion is not meant for facilities managed by the Government which involve felling of trees which are less than 75 trees per Ha. U/s 3(2) for RoFR Act,2006 in the proposed diversion area.
E.	A letter from the State Government certifying that the discussions and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of members of the Gram Sabha presents.	Issue of proposed diversion of Forest land of 4.88 Ha., in kuppagallu RF for excavation of link canal from Pulikanuma reservoir to the existing TBPLLC canal in Pulikanuma L.I.Scheme was discussed in Grama Sabha and decision was taken in the quorum of minimum of the 50% of members of concerned Grama Sabha.

F.	Obtaining the written consent or rejection of the Gram Sabha to the proposal.	There are no claims existing in the area proposed for diversion, however, written consents have been obtained from Grama Sabha of Peddathumbalam village of Adoni Mandal of Kurnool District stating that there are no Forest Dwellers eligible under RoFR Act, 2006 in Kuppagallu RF and there are no any objections by the Grama Sabha.
G.	A letter from the Stage Government certifying that the rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable, have been specifically safeguarded as per the section 3(1) (e) of the FRA.	There are no cases of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural communities where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3 (2) of RoFR Act,2006 in the area of kuppagallu RF of Adoni range which is proposed for diversion over 4.88 Ha., forest land for excavation of link canal from Pulikanuma reservoir to the existing TBPLLC canal in Pulikanuma L.I.Scheme.
