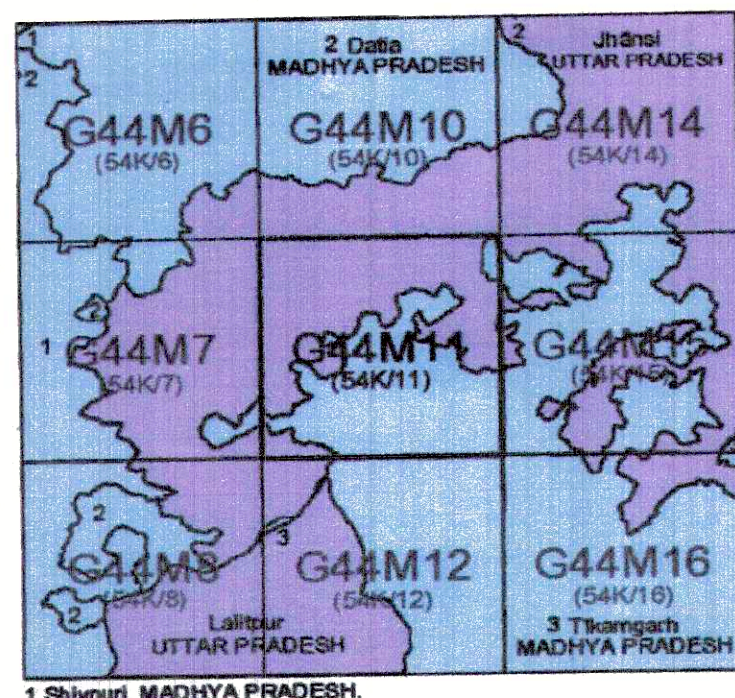

NOTES

- Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level
- Contours are approximate
- A relative height, e.g., 50, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a relief
- The exterior boundaries of areas of Reserved or Protected Forests are shown by green bands
- The kilometre stone numbers along the roads are shown in black type, e.g., '5' or '10' whereas station numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., '5'
- Tanks, shown dry in this area, usually contain water from July to December
- Wells and tube-wells are numerous throughout the area; only the important ones have been shown
- The state boundary between Madhya Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh States has been surveyed as pointed out by the local offices on the ground but has not been verified by the Government concerned
