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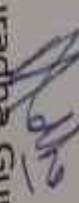

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF), Government of India's letter No 11-9/98 FC (pt) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of right under the Scheduled Tribes and other traditional forest dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2009 (FRA, for Short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 0.52 hectare of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Executive Engineer PWD (R&B) Division Samba under NABARD RIDF-XXV Scheme for construction of link road from Purnandal to Rajoli Tehsil Bari Brahmana District Samba falls within jurisdiction of Rajoli village(s) in Tehsil Bari Brahmana.

It is further certified that:-

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 0.52 hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meeting of the Forest Right Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed.
- (b) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their Consent to it;
