- The lease shall be in respect of Crude Oil and Natural Gas.
- 2. The lease shall be valid for a period of seven (7) years from 04.01.2013 to 03.01.2020.
- The lease shall be subject to the provisions of Oil Fields (Regulation and Development) Act, 1948 (53 of 1948) and the Petroleum & Natural Gas (P & NG) Rules, 1959 made thereunder as amended from time to time.
- 4. Royalty on Crude Oil, Natural Gas and Condensate shall be payable by the lessee as per such rates as may be fixed, from time to time, by the Central Government in consultation with the State Government. The royalty shall be payable on monthly basis and shall be payable by the last day of the month succeeding the period in respect of which it is payable.
- 5. The lessee shall, as soon as possible, provide the Central Government or its designated agency, free of cost, all data earlier obtained or to be




