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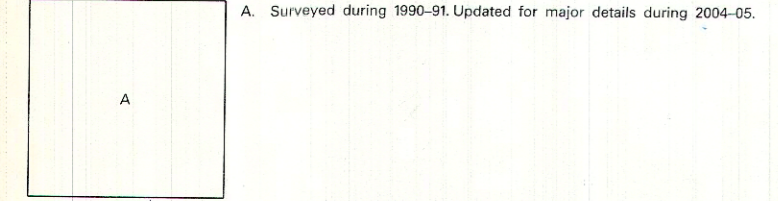
CONVENTIONAL SYMBOLS

- Express highway: with toll; with bridge; with distance stone
- Roads, metalled: according to importance
- Roads, double carriageway: according to importance
- Unmetalled road, Cart-track, Pack-track with pass, Foot-path
- Streams: with track in bed; undefined. Canal
- Dams: masonry or rock-filled; earthwork. Weir
- River: dry with water channel; with island & rocks. Tidal river
- Submerged rocks. Shoal. Swamp. Reeds
- Wells: lined; unlined. Tube-well. Spring. Tank: perennial; dry
- Embankments: road or rail; tank. Broken ground
- Railways, broad gauge: double; single with distance stone; do.
- Railways, other gauges: double; single with distance stone; do.
- Mineral line or tramway. Kilm. Cutting with tunnel
- Contours with sub-features. Rocky slopes. Cliffs
- Sand features: (flat, dune, hills (permanent), (slidiness/shifting)
- Towns or Villages: inhabited; deserted. Fort
- Huts: permanent; temporary. Tower. Antiquities. Fort
- Temple. Chhatri. Church. Mosque. Igah. Tomb. Graves
- Lighthouse. Lightship. Buoys: lighted; unlighted. Anchorage
- Mine. Vine on trellis. Grass. Scrub
- Palms: palm; other. Plantain. Conifer. Bamboo. Other trees
- Areas: cultivated; wooded. Surveyed tree
- Boundary: international
 - state: demarcated; undemarcated
 - district: subdivision, tahsil or taluk; forest
 - Pillars: surveyed; unlocated; village trijunction
- Heights, triangulated: station; point; approximate
- Bench-mark: geodetic; tertiary; canal
- Post office. Telegraph office. Overhead tank
- Rest house or inspection bungalow. Circuit house. Police station
- Camping ground. Forest: reserved; protected
- Spaced names: administrative; locally or tribal
- Hospital. Dispensary. Veterinary hospital
- Aerodrome. Helipad. Tourist site
- Power line: with pylons surveyed; with poles unsurveyed

NOTES

- Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level. Contours are approximates.
- A relative height, e.g. 30, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
- Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.
- Unmetalled roads and cart-tracks in this sheet are generally motorable in dry season. Permission to use those along canals is required from the irrigation authorities.
- Canal distance stones are 300 metres apart and every fifth stone is shown.
- 3,000-acre retriangulation done at Bhakra Dam Project Surveys with their numbers are shown as tertiary bench-marks thus: BM 244-1.

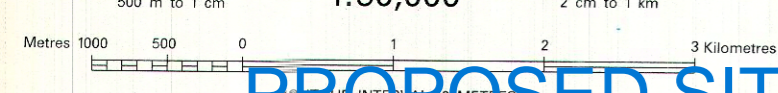
COMPILATION INDEX
