

- Whereas 3.2549356 Ha of forest land in Bhadarwah Forest Division was diverted in favour of NHIDCL, PMU, Doda for construction and upgradation of 2 land with paved shoulder of road from design Chainage 31.449 (Khellani, Pariyot) to Km 51.700 (Prem Nagar) Design length 20.251 Km) in the union territory of Jammu & Kashmir Package-1 of NH-244 vide File No. 9-JKB-092/2021-Jammu by Government of Indian (Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change conveyed by the Chief Conservator of Forests, (Nodal Officer) FCA vide No. PCCF/FCA/3390/4121-23 dated 12-03-2022.
- Whereas, after start of work by the user agency (NHIDCL) on the above said road, this office received a number of complaints regarding violation of Indian Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 by the User agency through Grievance Cell of Hon'ble LG UT of J&K, News published in the TV Channel, News Paper and a letter from Sh Dhananter Singh Kotwal, Chairman, District Development Council, Doda vide No. CDD/Council/Doda/2021-22/1025-27 dated 31-03-2021 addressed to Conservator of Forests, Chenab Circle, Doda endorsed to this office by the Conservator of Forests, Chenab Circle Doda vide No. 14858/CFC dated 31-03-2022.
- Whereas, in compliance to the Conservator of Forests, Chenab Circle, Doda's No. 14858/CFC dated 31-03-2022, a team of Forest Officers/officials was constituted for inquiry into the matter and was directed to submit factual report within 5 days vide this office No. BFO/Bhad/55-61 dated 04-04-2022.
- Whereas, the Inquiry team headed by Sh Abdul Rashid, Range Officer, Nuru Range of Forest Division Bhadarwah submitted a detailed report vide No. RON/Bhad/88 dated 28-04-2022 in which the following violation was verified on the spot:-
 - In Comptt. 1/M of Kellar Range of this Division, cutting of forest land & dumping of muck on 30 Mtr. X 30 Mtr. = 900 Sq. Mtrs. Or 0.09 Ha.
 - In Comptt. 1/M, of Kellar Range of this Division, damage to Forest land prior to accord of Forest Clearance, already reported by Range Officer, Kellar vide No. RO/262/K dated 05-10-2021 when work was started in State/Private land has also been re-verified by the team. (1) Chainage No. 35.250 at Nepli, 30 Mtrs x 80 Mtrs & (2) 21 Mtrs x 50 Mtrs at a distance of 15 Meters only, total 3450 Sq Mtrs. Or 0.345 Ha.
 - In chainage No. 41.270, Compt. No. 33/Ch of Chiralla Range near Gadsoo, illegally dumped muck in forest land downhill side measuring 30 Mtrs x 50 Mtrs = 1500 Sq. Mtrs or 0.15 Ha.
 - In chainage No. 42.300, Compt. No. 32/Ch of Chiralla Range near Bhadra, illegally dumped muck in forest land downhill side measuring 100 Mtrs x 50 Mtrs = 5000 Sq. Mtrs or 0.50 Ha.

5. **Whereas**, 2 Show Cause Notices were issued by this office to user agency vide No. DFO/Bhad/FCA/3685-91 dated 23-10-2021 for violation of IFCA 1980 prior to receipt of forest clearance the Range Officer, Kellar Range reported the damage & vide No. DFO/Bhad/FCA/5918-22 dated 15-03-2022 after receipt of forest clearance. But, till date the NHIDCL authorities have neither bothered to reply/response of the Show Cause Notices nor have attended the joint inspection/verification despite of telephonic requests/ written communications.
6. **Whereas**, Sh Shafer Iqbal, Range Officer, Chiralla after taking the charge of Chiralla Range has reported the following damage caused to forest land/trees/poles/saplings/Departmental Closures which was reported to him by the Block Forest Officer, Chiralla-II Block & Block Forest Officer, Jangalwar Block duly supported with 36 No. photographs of damage sites:-

(Part- 1st) Chiralla-2nd Block (From Pul Doda to Prem Nagar) Design chainage 31.449 Km to 71.700 Km)

- i) He noticed that a large number of cross cut logs were dumped at Pul Doda and Suigowari & it was also noted that the user agency has caused huge damage not only to trees, poles, saplings, but also damage to CAMPA closures of Forest Department as well as of social Forestry Department by dumping muck / debris on the downhill side of the road in Forest area Comptt. No. 32/Ch & 33/Ch.

It has been also submitted that the user agency has disposed / thrown all the muck / debris downhill side of road by using heavy machinery and thus spreading it to about 150 to 200 feet on the downhill side in the Forest. This action leads to burying of numerous sapling and regeneration and also damaging the trunks of trees. In addition to this their action has caused damage to closures (CAMPA) raised in Comptt. No 33/Ch and also some closures of Social Forestry got damaged.

The Block Officer, Chiralla had given a report and stated the damage was done by user agency. He had asked the user agency Manager Sh. Tajinder Panday and operator of Machinery to restrain from throwing of debris and damaging the Forest wealth, but they turned deaf ears to the Block Forest Officer directions.

It is further submitted that as per the report of Block Officer, Chiralla-2nd and Beat Guard Jagota-2nd that due to the throwing of debris / muck by user agency downhill

side of the road in Comptt. No 33/Ch 45 No. of PCC Fence Post of newly established CAMPA closures during 2021-22 got damaged. Besides these PCC fence posts, the plantation (Poly bags) done during the month of March 2022 also got damaged and some closures of Social Forestry are also damaged by the user agency. It has also been noted that the user agency has not adhered to the instruction while disposing the muck and dumped the same haphazardly on the steep slopes, thus damaging the flora of the eco-sensitive and slip prone zone.

The Block Forest Officer Chiralla-2nd has time to time reported the following damage of trees is as under:-

ii) **Damage to CAMPA closure established during 2021-22.** The 45 No. of PCC fence posts along with Barbed wire have been damaged by throwing the muck / debris downhill side of the road. The photographs of some of damaged PCC fence posts are attached and some PCC fence posts got buried under the muck / debris. And also Social Forestry closures damaged. It has also been reported by the Block Officer, Chiralla that during the month of March 2022, 3500 Poly Bags plantation was done in CAMPA Closure established in 2021-22, but due to the muck disposal other then the dumping sites all the Poly bag plantation got damaged either under the debris or by throwing muck, boulders etc. in the closure.

Besides, above reported damage by the field staff, the Range Officer, Chiralla on 21-07-2022 also observed damage of one Chir green tree of Dia-Class 30-40 cm and also 4 other Green Chir trees detailed below whose roots have been exposed due to earth cutting beyond approved width of road and there is every apprehension of damage to these trees as well.

No. 30/Ch, 32/Ch, & 33/Ch, beside dumping site by throwing the same downhill side of the road by causing huge loss to the Forest flora and soil fertility at more than 20 sites the Geo-coordinates of some location where the Forest land damaged is as under:-

The machines of the user agency have already dumped thousand of tone of muck / debris including boulders, Stones, Excavated Earth on Forest land in Comptt. No. 12/Jwr, 13/Jwr 6/Jwr, beside dumping site by throwing the same downhill side of the road by causing huge loss to the Forest flora and soil fertility at various sites.

On steep slopes the muck has been disposed by the user agency directly into the river Chenab thereby affecting the aquatic life. An area of about 2 Ha (approx) Forest land has already been brought under the illegal use, for dumping of debris. These actions lead to burying of numerous saplings and regeneration and also damaging the trunks of trees. The detail of Forest land affected is as under:-

It is very unfortunate that the user agency has not only defied the direction but has become responsible for vandalizing the Forest as if it was allotted to them for destruction. In addition to the damage done to the downhill side, the unmanaged and destructive earth cutting on the uphill side has also rendered the area prone to sliding and erosion. There is every apprehension that some more trees are prone to damage as their roots have been exposed due to earth cutting.

7. Whereas, the Range Officer, Neru Range as an Inquiry Officer and Range Officer, Chiralla Range have recommended recovery of cost of damage @ 10 times of revised standard rates of 2018& NPV, for violation of terms/conditions for diversion of forest land for widening/upgradation of the said road from Khellani to Thathri.

8. Whereas, from the perusal of reports of Inquiry Officer (Range Officer, Neru) & Range Officer, Chiralla Range of Forest Division Bhadarwah, violation of following conditions of Forest Clearance accorded for above said road by the Govt. of India, has been proved/established:

B-Conditions

vii) That user agency shall not dump muck on forest land (other than dumping sites proposed in the proposal).

xiii) No damage will be done to the adjoining forest land including flora and fauna.

9. Whereas, as per provisions 1.21 (iii) (a) of Chapter 1, Court Orders and general clarifications, of Indian Forest Conservation Act, 1980, which reads as under:-

a) In case the offence is proved then the penalty shall be imposed for violation committed over forest area without approval equal to twice the normal NPV.

10. Whereas, in compliance to above detailed provision of the Indian Forest Conservator Act, 1980, 02 (Two) time cost of damage done to the forest land/trees/poles/saplings etc. by the NHIDCL PMU Doda is calculated as under:-




