In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of 'evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of Rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that 2.00 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in Ellutla Reserve Forests in favour of Smt. J.C. Vijaya, Tadipatri for grant of quarry lease for Barytes in Sy. No. 01/P (Compt. No. 558) of Ellutla RF, Putlur mandal, Ananthapuramu district under RoFR Act, 2006

It is further certified that;

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 2.00 hectares of forest land proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultation and meeting of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub- Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure "**Grama Sabha Resolutions**."
- (b) The proposal for such diversion (with-full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/ local language) have been placed before concerned Gram Sabha of forest-dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA,
- (c) The concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the Gram Sabha of Ellutla village of Putlur mandal is enclosed [as annexure]
- (d) The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when "there was a quorum of minimum 50 % of the members of Gram Sabha present,
- (e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Grama Sabha has given their consent to it;
- (f) The proposal does not involve recognized rights of Primitive Tribal groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities,
- (g) The proposed area of diversion in Ellutla RF does not fall in the Scheduled Tribe area and therefore does not attract the provision of RoFR Act 2006. Consequent on which identification and settlement of rights under FRA does not arise.
- (h) There are no Forest dwellers in the proposed diversion area.
