

JUSTIFICATION OF PROJECT

The existing road from Rinchenpong Bazaar to Dakbunglow which has total length of 930.00 metres has Forest area covering 570.00 metres in length and private land covering 360.00 metres in length. The said road used to be horse riding road during the time of Chogyal and later on the same road got minor upgradation under the supervision of Roads & Bridges Department with total road formation of just 3-4 metres. Since, the traffic volume is increasing every passing day, the present road formation is not sufficient for ease flow of two way traffic.

The same road leads to very popular tourist spots of the area like Old British Bungalow, Old 17th century Monastery, Poison lake and many more. The road also gets connected further with PMGSY road which leads to Upper Hatidhunga village at the left side where the college of Hotel Management is under proposal. The road leading to old 17th century monastery also gets connected from this Rinchenpong Bazaar to Dakbunglow road where the major project of Buddhist God's statue is coming up in the area above this Monastery. Due to the narrow road formation, the local public are facing lots of problem to transport construction materials for their house construction and similarly to transport materials for Government sanctioned schemes. Since, the existing road itself passes through Forest area where half of the road formation is already within forest area, the remaining formation width required is 3-4 metres which can solve the ongoing problem faced by general public and will be ease for two way traffic flow as the area is under development with many tourism projects.
