In compliance of the Ministry of Environmental and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 where in the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of right under the Schedule Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non- forest purposes.

It is certified that 39.00 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Madhya Pradesh Water Resources Department for Satdhara Tank Scheme in Tikamgarh District falls within jurisdiction of Lidhora Jangal & Lidhora Ugad Village of Nagar Parishad Lidhora Khas of Lidhora Tahsil.

## It is further certified that :-

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of right under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 39.00 hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Right Committee (s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure 1 to 3.
- (b) The Proposal for such diversion (with the details of the project and its implication, in vernacular/local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of Forest Dwellers, who eligible under FRA.
- (c) The each of concerned Gram sabha(s), has certified that all information /process under the FRA have been carried out, and that have given their consent to the proposal diversion and the compensation ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposal diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the Lidhora Ugad & Lidhora Jangal village of Nagar Parishad Lidhora Khas as enclosed as annexure-I.

- (d) The discussion and decision on such proposal had taken placed only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the member of Gram Sabha Present.
- (e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Shaba have given their consent to it.
- (f) The rights of primitive Tribal groups and pre agricultures, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1) of the FRA.
