It is to informed that Government of India / Government of Telangana State, Hyderabad has accorded in -principle Stage-I approval for diversion of 0.623 Ha of Forest land in Wanaparthy Forest Block in Compt. No. 520 of Wanaparthy Reserve Forest Block in Wanaparthy Division, for laying of pipeline and construction of structures in Segment -1/6 (Wanaparthy) – for providing safe drinking water supply in Wanaparthy constituency in Wanaparthy District – under Telangana Drinking Water Supply project – in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP Circle, Mahabubnagar.

✓ The User agency is requested to submit the compliance report on the following conditions:

Condition No. II: The demarcation of the forest area proposed for diversion shall be carried out by erecting cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters at the cost of user agency shall pay an amount of Rs.50800.00/-(total length is 0.621Kms,2 big pillar @ Rs.8000/-per pillar and 29 small pillar @ Rs.1200/- per pillar).

Condition No. III: The compensatory afforestation scheme proposed in Compt. No 520 of Rajapet CA Block of Wnaparthy Range, Wanaparthy Division at the total cost of RS 9,50,000.00.

PDF compressor: Free Version Condition No. IV: The user agency shall pay the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land as per the orders of the Hon'ble supreme court, clated: 28.03.2008 and 09.05.2008 in L.A. Nos. 826 in 566 with related 15's in Writ petition (Civil) No. 202/1995 and as per the vide state 'government issued by No.124EFS&T(FOR.I)Dept., dated:27.07.2010, Wanaparthy RF Block is Southern Thorn forests type. As per the classification of the forest the rate of NPV is fixed as Rs. 6,26,000.00 per Ha. Accordingly the user agency shall pay Rs. 3,89,998.00 for diversion of 0.623 Ha Forest Land.

- Condition No. V: Additional amount of Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after revision of the same by lhe Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Julure, Shall be paid by the User Agency. The User agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
- Condition No. VII: Any free felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the Forest Department.
- Condition No. X: The Forest Land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal.
- Condition No. XI: The Layout plan of the proposed for diversion shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department of person without prior approval of the Central Government.
- Condition No., XII: Original copy of the RoFR certificates or copy of the RoFR certificate duly attested with official seal of the concerned competent authority shall be furnished.
- Condition No.XIV: The User Agency shall be responsible for any loss to the flora/fauna in the surroundings.
- Condition No. XV: The Total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 0.623 Ha. In case the land is not taken over by the User Agency or the same is not used for the stipulated purpose within a period of two years, then the area shall be taken back by the Forest Department.
- Condition No. XVI: The Forest Department may impose from time to time any other condition (S) in the interest of conservation, protection and /or development of forests.
- Condition No.XVII: Other Conditions specified in the GOI, MoEF, letters dated: 03.01.2005, 13.05.2011, 16.06.2011, 13.02.2014 and 07.11.2014 shall also be compiled with by principal chief conservator of Forests, Telangana State, Hyderabad and User Agency. with which they are concerned.

The Superintendent Engineer, RWS&S, TDWSP Circle, Mahabubnagar is requested to upload the above demand notice on the Ministries portal for vetting of Nodal Officer i.e., APCCF (FCA). After vetting and acceptance of the demand, the District Forest Officer, Wanaparthy can be raised the demand with the user agency and see that the payment can be done in e-portal method only. The mode for remittance of Compensatory levies shall be through e-payment portal of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate change only. The User Agency has to generate challan upon acceptance of demand raised & transfer funds through online only into any of the following Ad-hoc CAMPA accounts of Telangana state,

> The User Agency is also to pay an amount of Rs 75000/- (Rupees Seventy Five Thousand only) towards cost of extraction and transportation of trees in the -proposed area and Rs 50,800/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Eight hundred only) towards cost of construction of boundary pillars. The total amount of Rs 1,25,800/-. The above amount is to be deposit with the District Forest Officer, Wanaparthy i.e. A/c No 62487358914 of State Bank of Hyderabad, Wanaparthy Branch.

> Hence the User Agency is further requested to submit compliance report on the conditions stipulated to by government along with all necessary enclosures in six sets in original so as to submit the compliance report to the Government for according the Stage-II approval. Until final approval is received the user agency should not take up any activity in the area proposed for diversion as it attracts the provisions of the Forest Conservation Act, 1980.
