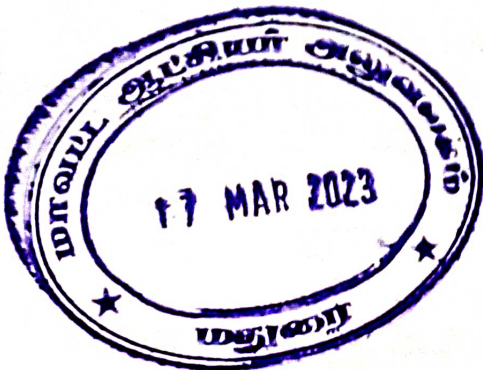

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MOEF) Government of India's Letter No.11-9/98-FC (Pl) dated: 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ("FRA" for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non - forest purposes read with MOEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MOEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 0.1275 hectares of Forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Block Development Officer (Village Panchayat), Vadippatti Panchayat Union, Madurai District for Carry out formation Work of new Black Topped Road works from Vikkiramangalam to Kadupatti villages across Mannadimangalam R.F of Madurai Forest Division, Madurai in Usilampatti Taluk, Madurai District.

It is further certified that :

- a) The Complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 0.1275 ha of Forest area proposed for diversion.
- b) Certified that there are no Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers in Mannadimangalam R.F. of Usilampatti Taluk, Madurai District and Consequently, no claims have been received under this Act with respect to the area proposed for BT road Work in this path.
- c) Certified that there are no Primitive Tribal Groups (PTG) and pre-Agricultural Communities (PAC) in the Mannadimangalam R.F. of Usilampatti Taluk, Madurai District. So, the recognized rights of PTG and PAC are not affected.
