## <u>FULL JUSTIFICATION FOR LOCATING THE PROJECT IN FOREST AREA</u> (UN-AVOIDANCE OF THE FOREST AREA FOR THE PURPOSE)

NH353C is the newly converted National Highway. It is the important Highway starting from Sironcha to Athmakur passing through Kaleshwaram, Mahadevpur, Bhupalpally, Parkala etc.

The existing road is proposed for widening in forest area in-order to meet the norms of MoRTH, Gol, New Delhi. The National Highway NH-353C which connects NH-63 and NH-163 and important mandals like Parakala, Ghanpur, Bhupalpally, Kataram, Mahadevpur in Jayashanker Bhupalpally district and Sironcha mandal in maharashtra state. The main marketing facility availability is at warangal through which the people will be benefited with direct marketing their agricultural products by transporting on the above said road.

Widening of this stretch of this important NH 353C is absolutely necessary in view of the traffic intensity and also it helps in overall development of backward area of the district besides facilitating easy communication.

An area of 258.028 Ha has been diverted to I&CAD Dept vide Govt of Telangana G.O.Ms.No.05 Dt:17-01-2018 out of which an area of 5.1808 Ha is required for re-diversion for widening of road. Hence the NOC is obtained from the primary user agency i.e I&CAD and the same is enclosed for reference

There is no other alternative except proposing for widening of the existing road in forest area in-order to meet the norms of MoRTH, GoI, New Delhi.
