

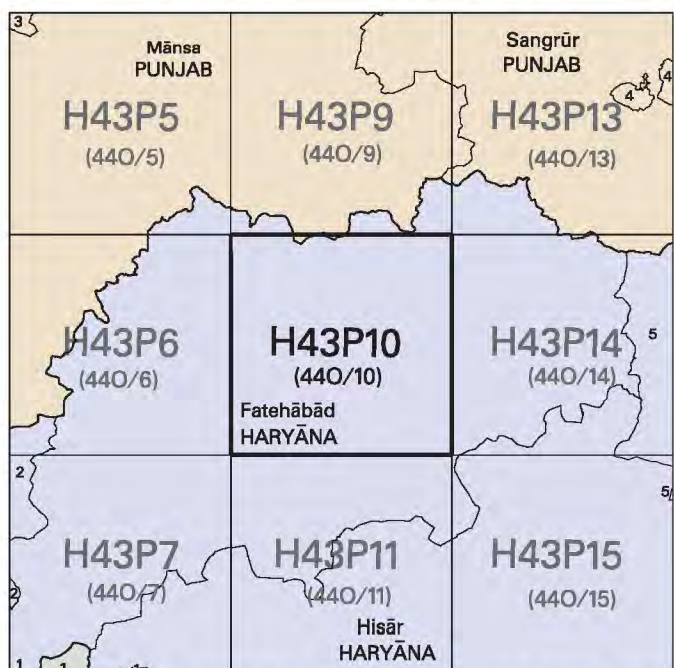

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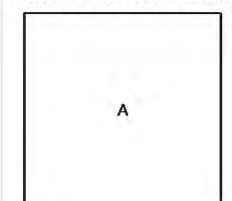

NOTES

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet only the important ones have been shown.
All cart-tracks and unmetalled roads along canals are motorable throughout the year. Permission to use this is required from the irrigation authorities. Other cart-tracks and unmetalled roads are generally motorable in dry season.
A relative height, e.g., 40, marked along a canal indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
Canal distance stones are 1000 feet apart and every existing fifth stone is shown.
The state boundary between Haryana and Punjab States has been surveyed as printed out by the local officials on the ground but has not been verified by the Government concerned.
3,000-acre reclamation of Bhakra Dam Project Survey based on Origin 30° 00' N, 75° 15' E with their numbers are shown as tertiary bench-marks thus: 12 431 BM 216.4

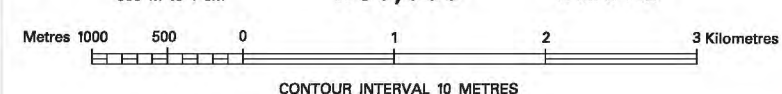
COMPILATION INDEX

CONTOUR INTERVAL 10 METRES

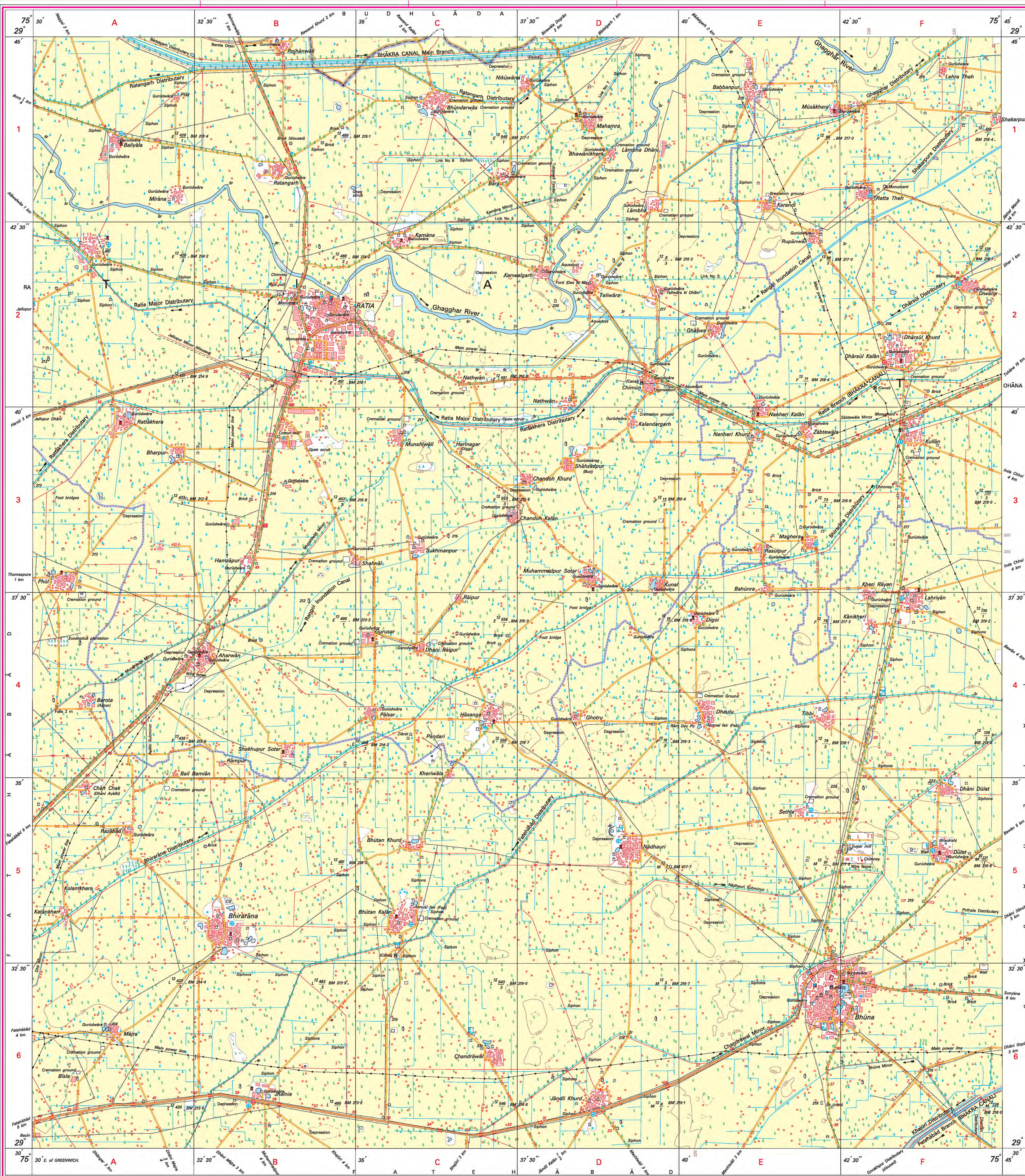
