In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 28th October 2014 it is certified that **0.111** hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favor of National Highways Authority of India, (NHAI) for "Additional forest land diversion required for Eastern Yamuna canal falling in Shamli District for "Four laning of Panipat (Start from junction with Existing Km of NH-44 at Panipat) -to Shamli (End at its junction with Existing 39+300 of SH- 12) of NH-709AD in the State of Uttar Pradesh" Package -1(0.000 to 35.580)" (Purpose for diversion of forest land) in Shamli district Chainage falls within Km 34.500 jurisdiction of Lilaun villages in Tehsil Shamli i.e in the District Shamli.

It is certified that the as per the Gazette Notification no. 4041/XIV dated 15th October 1954, it is notified that forest land proposed to be diverted is plantation which was notified as "Protected Forest" less than 75 years prior to the 13th day of December 2005 and is located in villages having no record population of Schedule Tribes, as per the Census -2001 and Census-2011. The proposal does not involve recognized rights of primitive tribal groups and pre-Agricultural Forest dwelling communities.
