NOTES

A relative height, Δ , represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.

The course of the Satluj River is liable to continual change owing to shifting of the river bed. Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to March.

Damla stones along canals and protective embankments are 1,000 feet apart and every existing fifth stone is shown.

Permission to use cart-tracks and unmetalled roads along canals is required from the Irrigation authorities.

A relative height, e.g., ΔP , marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.

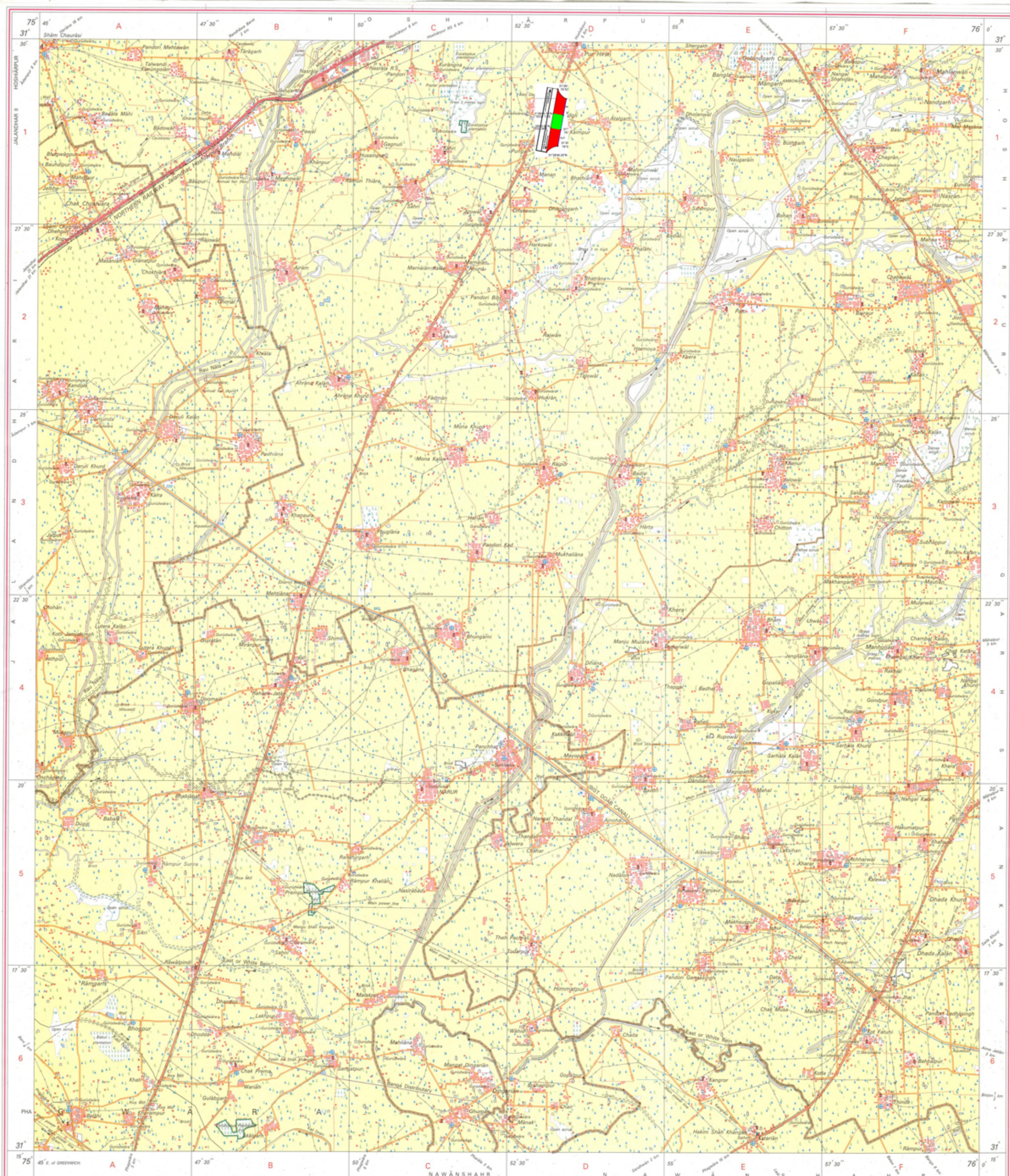
