TO WHOWSOEVER IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and forests (MoEF) Government of India's cr No. 11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 where in the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act. 2006 (FRA for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes it is certified that **6.50** hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favor of **Assistant Commissioner Tribal Development Kanker** (name of user agency) For **The Establishment of Eklavya Model Residential School** in Uttar Bastar Kanker District falls within jurisdiction of **Surhi Village in Narharpur Tehsil**. This area does not contain any non-forest revenue land.

This further certified that :

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire **6.50** hectares of forest area proposed for Diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights committee(s), Gram sabha (s), Sub division Level Committee (s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure **B** to **S**.
- (b) The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest-dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA;
- (c) The each of concerned Gram Sabha (s), has certified that all formalities/proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issued by the gram sabha of **Surhi** villages(s) is enclosed as annexure **I**.
- (d) The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of the gram sabha present;
- (e) The Tank for forest land for facilities manages by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram sabhas have given their consent to it;
- (f) The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1) to the FRA.
