

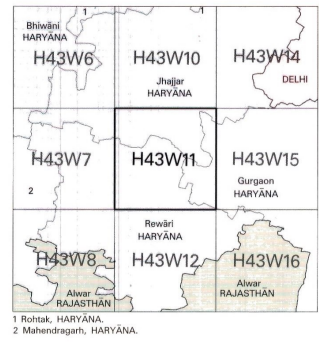

CONVENTIONAL SYMBOLS

- Express highway: with toll, with bridge, with distance stone
- Roads, metalled: according to importance
- Roads, double cartway: according to importance
- Unmetalled road, Cart-track, Pack-track with pass, Foot-path
- Streams: with track in bed, underlined, Canal
- Dams: masonry or rock-filled, earthwork, Weir
- River: dry with water channel, with island & rocks, Tidal river
- Submerged rocks, Shoal, Swamp, Reeds
- Wells: lined, unlined, Tube well, Spring, Tank, permanent, dry
- Enclosures: road or rail, tank, Broken ground

NOTES

Contours are approximate.
Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
A station height, e.g. 100m, represents the approximate height in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
Distance stones along JALANAH LAL NERU CANAL are 1200 metres apart and every existing stone is shown, whereas along other canals these are 1000 feet apart and every existing 5th stone is shown.
Tanks shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to March.
Unmetalled roads and cart tracks in this sheet are generally routeable in dry season. Permission to use these along canals is required from the Irrigation authorities.
3,000-acre reforestation project of Bharat Dam Project survey with their numbers are shown as tertiary bench-marks.
