

CERTIFICATE OF JUSTIFICATION FOR LOCATING THE PROJECT IN FOREST LAND

The construction of road Pharkian Gali-Putakhan Gali is being planned with intended to connect the border out post along the LoC in Kupwara district of Jammu & Kashmir, to provide logistic support to the troops deployed in the axis. The road will be located near the international boundary. Defence forces will utilize this infrastructure for movement of their men and material.

Initially, the requirement of construction of fair weather motorable CL-9 specification road connecting Putkhan Gali with main axis (Pharkian Gali) in approx length 13.00 km was promulgated under 15 year LTPP for GS roads under priority-II to be completed till 2022 by Army HQ (MO-4) vide IHQ (MO4) letter No.A/40071/MO4 dated 31 Dec 2007 which was further superseded vide of DGMO/MO-4 Dte letter No.A/40071/MO-4 dated 19 Jan 2010 under LTPP priority-II program. Pharkian Gali-Putakhan Gali road is strategically important road and its construction work is required to be taken up immediately and hence forest clearance is required.
