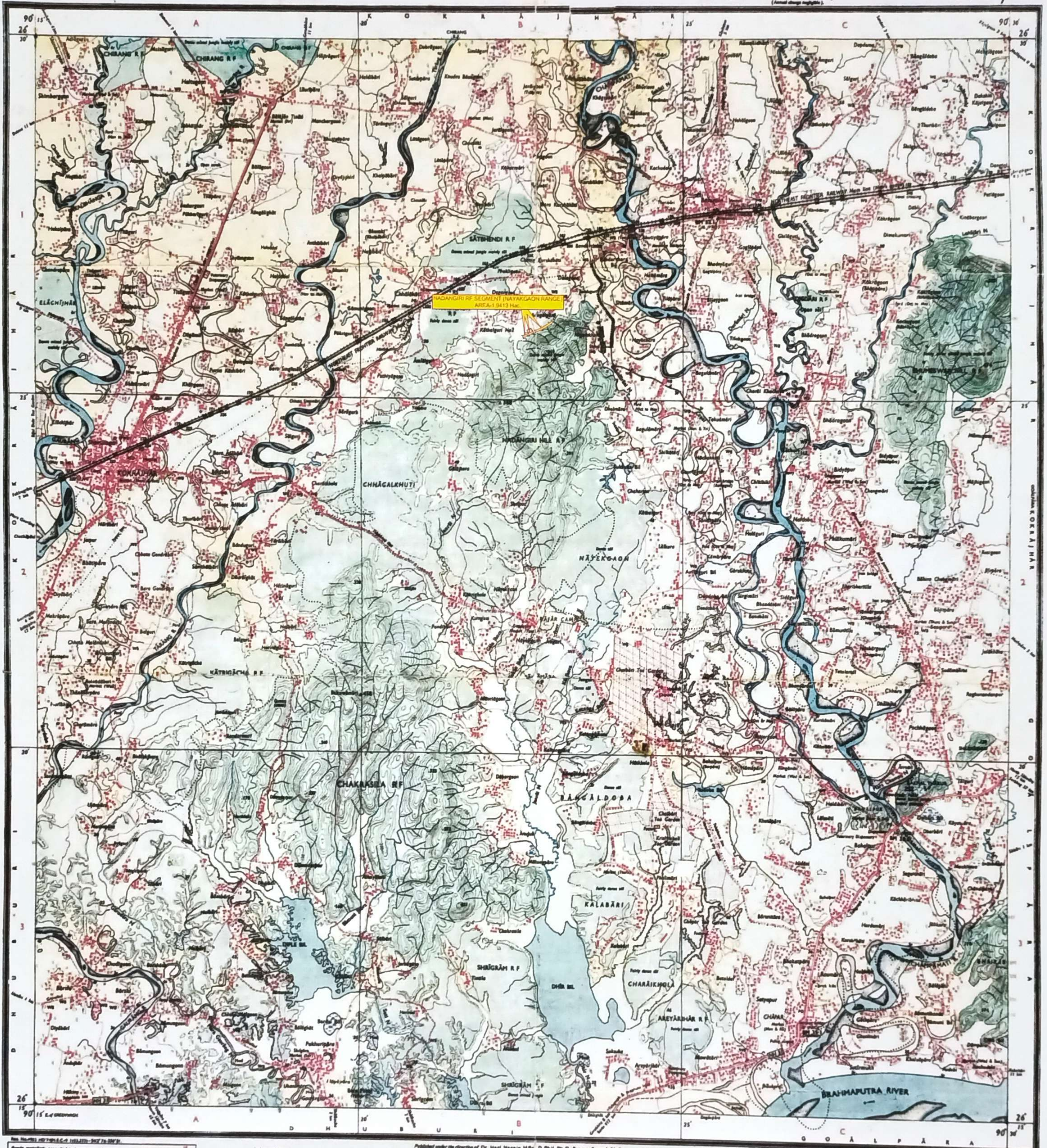

The information given along roads, railways and rivers is shown in red. The area adjoining the Brahmaputra River is liable to change owing to seasonal fluctuations; thickness of the floor and adjacent flooded during rainy season. All unshaded roads inside the Tea Gardens are indicated in dry season. Permission to use these roads is required from the Tea Garden authorities. Boundaries of Reserved Forests have not been shown for want of information. The alignment of the additional boundaries, shown on this sheet, are based on the information supplied by the Deputy Director of Survey. Army has been put to be verified.
