NOTES -

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.  
Contours are approximate.  
A relative height, e.g., 2r, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.  
The kilometre stone numbers along the railway are shown in slant type, e.g., 'g' whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., '5'.  
Unmetalled roads and cart-tracks along canal embankments are usually motorable. Permission to use these is shown from the irrigation authorities. Other unmetalled roads in this sheet are motorable in dry season.  
A relative height, e.g., 2r, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.  
Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to January.
